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
**PETITION FOR REVIEW**

AND NOW comes Petitioner, Casey Michael Maines, by and through Ronald L. Collins, Esquire, who Petitions your Honorable Court as follows:

1. That Petitioner is Casey Micheal Maines, of 24 Maines Lane, Clearfield, Pennsylvania, 16830.
2. That Petitioner's Driver License No. 28432568.
3. That Respondent is the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation.
4. That by Official Notice dated May 27, 2005, Respondent notified Petitioner that his operating privileges were being suspended for a period of ninety days (90) as the result of his conviction of the offense of Truancy under Section 1333 of the Public School Code on September 16, 2004. A copy of said Notice is hereinafter attached as Exhibit "A".
5. That Petitioner filed a Notice of Appeal of said Summary Convictions in Clearfield County which appeal is currently pending.
6. That is said Summary Convictions are vacated on appeal, Respondent will no longer have a basis upon which to suspend Petitioner's operating privileges for these offenses.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests your Honorable Court to review the actions of Respondent in suspending Petitioner's operating privileges based on the ultimate result of said appeal filed in Clearfield County.

Dear MR. MAINES:

On 05/12/2005 you were convicted of Truancy under Section 1333 of the Public School Code. As a result, your driving privilege (or your right to apply for a driver's license) is being suspended for 90 DAY(S) as required by Section 1338.1 of the Public School Code.

In order to comply with this sanction you are required to return any current driver's license, learner's permit and/or temporary driver's license (camera card) in your possession no later than the effective date listed. If you cannot comply with the requirements stated above, you are required to submit a DL16LC Form or a sworn affidavit stating that you are aware of the sanction against your driving privilege. Failure to comply with this notice shall result in this Bureau referring this matter to the Pennsylvania State Police for prosecution under SECTION 1571(a)(4) of the Vehicle Code.

Although the law mandates that your driving privilege is under suspension even if you do not surrender your license, Credit will not begin until all current driver's license product(s), the DL16LC Form, or a letter acknowledging your sanction is received in this Bureau.

WHEN THE DEPARTMENT RECEIVES YOUR LICENSE OR ACKNOWLEDGEMENT, WE WILL SEND YOU A RECEIPT. IF YOU DO NOT RECEIVE THIS RECEIPT WITHIN 15 DAYS CONTACT THE DEPARTMENT IMMEDIATELY. OTHERWISE, YOU WILL NOT BE GIVEN CREDIT TOWARD SERVING THIS SANCTION.

The effective date of suspension is 07/01/2005, 12:01 a.m.

Approximately 30 days before your driving privilege is eligible for restoration, provided credit has begun on your suspension, you will receive a letter that identifies the steps you must follow for restoration of your driving privilege. When you receive the letter, please read it care-

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


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
**ORDER**
