## ROAD VIEWERS.

### CLEARFIELD COUNTY SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield in and for said county, on the 29 day of June, A. D. 1869, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Pike in the said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway leading from <sup>changed</sup> Chestnut Ridge school House to Ellis Askey's farm.

Report as to damages &c

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons <sup>vacate</sup> to view and <sup>supply</sup> ~~the~~ the same according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

James Mitchell, Jordan Read & Jonathan Hartshorn who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion <sup>vacate</sup> ~~to lay out~~ for such road, they shall proceed <sup>supply</sup> the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.



To the Honorable the Judges of Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace in and for the County of Calaveras—We the persons appointed by the within order of Court to view-vacate & supply the road within the within order mentioned do report, That after giving due public notice of the time and place of meeting, We met agreeably thereto on the 18th day of Sept. A.D. 1869 and after being duly sworn according to Law We proceeded to view and vacate the following road to wit Beginning at a point on the public road leading from Chestnut Ridge School House to the Ellis Oskey Farm Thence through land of Thomas Bloom N. 40. W. 20. 4 per<sup>cent</sup> Thence N. 40 1/2. W. 33.6 per<sup>cent</sup> to line of David Wags— To supply the above road We viewed and layed out and do now return for public use the following road to wit Beginning where we quit vacating thence on line between Thomas Bloom & David Wags S 3. W. 40.6 per<sup>cent</sup> to line of Ross Bloom thence along said line through land of Thomas Bloom's S. 87. E. 43 per<sup>cent</sup> to Point where we began to vacate, And we also further report that there will be no damage to owners of Property by the making of the above described laid out road
