1. By a letter dated, June 02, 2005, the Department of Transportation (Department) notified the defendant/petitioner, Timothy W. Slawianowski, that it was suspending his operating privilege for a period of one year, pursuant to Section 1547 of the Vehicle Code.

2. On June 27, 2005, the defendant/petitioner filed a timely appeal from the notice of suspension referred to in Paragraph 1 with the Office of the Prothonotary of Beaver County.

4. Venue for appeals from determinations of the Department of Transportation is governed by 42 Pa.C.S. §933. Section 933 reads in pertinent part:

**933. Appeals from government agencies**

**(a) General rule.**--Except as otherwise prescribed by any general rule adopted pursuant to section 503 (relating to reassignment of matters), each court of common pleas shall have jurisdiction of appeals from final orders of government agencies in the following cases:



5. In the instant case the underlying arrest and refusal on which the subject appeal is taken occurred in Sandy Creek Township, Clearfield County, Pa. See copy of criminal complaint attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

6. The only proper venue for petitioner's appeal of his license suspension for chemical testing refusal is in the Clearfield County Common Pleas Court because that is the county where the defendant/petitioner was arrested on August 15, 2004.
