PETITION/APPLICATION FOR RELIEF
PURSUANT TO 18 Pa.C.S.A. §6105(f)(1)

NOW COMES, Petitioner, BRANDON A. LONGE, individually and by his agent and grandmother, DOROTHY LONGE, pursuant to General Power of Attorney dated January 5, 2004 (photocopy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "A"), seeking relief from denial of firearm purchase and in support thereof, states the following:

1. Your Petitioner/Applicant is Brandon A. Longe, an adult individual, age 21 (d.o.b. 5/28/84), who currently resides in the Village of Karthaus, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, with a mailing address of P. O. Box 96, Karthaus, PA 16845.

2. Your Petitioner is currently a member of the U. S. Army/National Guard and as of mid-March, 2005 just completed a 14.5 month active tour of duty overseas in Iraq as part of "Operation Iraqi Freedom". A photocopy of your Petitioner's military orders directing him to active duty for "Operation Iraqi Freedom" are attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "B".

3. Your Petitioner has been, since his return from overseas, domiciled in the Village of Karthaus, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, with a mailing address of P. O. Box 96, Karthaus, PA 16845.

4. At present, your Petitioner is working as a

painting/laborer, but he is subject to recall at any time by the U. S. Army/National Guard for a second tour of duty in "Operation Iraqi Freedom". A photocopy of your Petitioner's military discharge orders, and a letter from his Unit Commander explaining the "subject to recall" dated August 15, 2005, are attached hereto and made a part hereof collectively as Exhibit "C".

5. Due to your Petitioner's subject to military recall status, his designated agent, Dorothy Longe, joins in this Petition should your Petitioner later become unavailable for any subsequent proceedings concerning this Petition.

6. On or about November 30, 2003, Your Petitioner attempted to purchase a rifle, for hunting purposes (hereafter called "firearm") at Grice Gun Shop situate at 216 Reed Street, Clearfield, PA 16830, but said requested purchase was denied after the gun dealer performed a Pennsylvania Instant Background Records Check.

7. When Petitioner was unable to complete the purchase of the firearm from the aforementioned gun dealer, he immediately submitted a challenge of said denial to the Pennsylvania State Police, Firearms Division - PICS, but said denial was confirmed by letter from the Pennsylvania State Police, dated December 10, 2003, asserting that your Petitioner was subject to a prohibition as set forth in 18 Pa.C.S.A. §6105(c)(4). A copy of the letter of December 10, 2003 is attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "D".

8. Your Petitioner's challenge was denied "for his

1998 involuntary commitments" to the Clearfield-Jefferson County Mental Health facility on the following dates:

- (i) June 24, 1998;
- (ii) September 7, 1998; and
- (iii) December 14, 1998.

9. Your Petitioner was a juvenile (age 14) at the time of the aforementioned commitments and was only committed by virtue of untrue and unfounded allegations made by his mother, Deanna K. Spingola Brady Plubell, who does suffer from both medical and mental illnesses and who was using your Petitioner, in what his current physician describes as "Munchausen by Proxy".

10. Your Petitioner does not now suffer nor has he ever been diagnosed with a mental illness or mental disability. Attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "E" is a sworn statement from your Petitioner's family physician, Larry G. Adams, M. D.

11. Due to the unsettled environment your Petitioner was exposed to while living with his mother, your Petitioner went to live with his grandparents, Thomas F. Longe and Dorothy Longe beginning in 1999.

12. Your Petitioner has never been convicted of a criminal offense in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, or in any other state.

13. Your Petitioner currently is and always has been in "good standing" with the U. S. Army/National Guard.

14. At no time has your Petitioner ever posed a risk

to himself or any other person by virtue of his possessing a firearm.

WHEREFORE, your Petitioner, by his agent prays that this Honorable Court enter an Order, as authorized by 18 Pa.C.S.A. § 6105(f) (1) which states:


(A) Petitioner, Brandon A. Longe, may possess a firearm without risk to himself or to any other person;

(B) As of the date of this Order, Petitioner, Brandon A. Longe, is no longer under any disability or prohibition as enumerated in 18 Pa. C.S.A. §6105 which would preclude him from possessing, using, controlling, selling, transferring, manufacturing or obtaining a license to possess, use, control, sell, transfer or manufacture a firearm in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and

(C) The Pennsylvania State Police are directed to expunge, redact and/or otherwise remove from its records, particularly those maintained under the Pennsylvania Instant Check System, all records showing Petitioner, Brandon A. Longe, was ever committed to the Clearfield-Jefferson County MH/MR facility at any time prior to December 14, 2003.



GENERAL POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW EVERYONE BY THESE PRESENTS, which are intended to constitute a Nondurable General Power of Attorney, **THAT I, Brandon A. Longe**, having an address at Brandon A. Longe, P.O. Box 96, Karthaus, PA 16845, hereby make, constitute and appoint **Dorothy Longe**, having an address at P.O. Box 96, Karthaus, PA 16845, as my agent **TO ACT** in my name, place and stead in any way which I could do, if I were personally present, to the extent that I am permitted by law to act through an agent:

- (a) to ask, demand, sue for, recover and receive all manner of goods, chattels, debts, rents, interest, sums of money and demands whatsoever, due or to become due, and to execute, acknowledge and deliver acquittances, receipts, releases, satisfactions or other discharges for the same;
- (b) to make, execute, endorse, accept and deliver in my name or in the name of my agent all checks, notes, drafts, warrants, securities, stock certificates, certificates of deposit, bonds, acknowledgments, and any other agreements, certificates or instruments of any nature, as my agent may deem necessary or appropriate;
- (c) to cause securities or other property to be held or registered in the name of a nominee or nominees or in any other form; to vote any and all shares of stock or other securities and to execute proxies or other instruments with respect to such stock or securities;
- (d) to deposit and withdraw any sums to or from any bank, savings or similar account maintained by me; to open or cause to be opened any safe deposit box in my name and to examine and remove any or all of the contents of such box; and to conduct such other banking transactions as my agent may deem necessary or appropriate;
- (e) to deal with all matters relating to insurance, including the procurement and maintenance thereof; however, notwithstanding the powers given my agent in this and other provisions of this power of attorney, my agent shall have no incidents of ownership in any life insurance policy in which I own an interest and which insures the life of my agent;
- (f) to enter and take possession of any real or personal property belonging to me or to which I may be entitled, and to receive and take for me and in my name any rents, issues and profits of any such property; and to purchase, invest in, reinvest in, sell, exchange, lease, grant options upon, convey, assign, transfer, encumber or otherwise dispose of any real or personal property of any nature and wherever situate; and to execute, acknowledge and deliver all contracts, deeds, leases, mortgages, transfers to trusts, bills of sale, assignments, extensions, satisfactions, releases, waivers, consents, and any other agreements, writings and instruments of

any nature affecting any real or personal property, as my agent may deem necessary or appropriate;

(g) to commence any actions or proceedings, for the recovery of any real or personal property or for any other purpose; to appear in, answer and defend any actions or proceedings commenced against me; and to prosecute, maintain, appeal, discontinue, compromise, settle and adjust all actions, proceedings, accounts, dues and demands that now or hereafter may exist, as my agent may deem necessary or appropriate;

(h) to create, amend or terminate one or more trusts, partnerships, corporations, co-tenancies or any other form of ownership or entity for the purpose of dealing with any property or property interest of any nature that I may have or hereafter acquire, under such terms and with such provisions as my agent may deem necessary or appropriate; and to transfer any or all property in which I have an interest into any trusts, partnerships, corporations, co-tenancies or other entities, whether created by me or my agent or otherwise (and, in this regard, that my agent may be a remainderman, partner, shareholder, co-tenant or beneficiary of any such entity shall not affect the validity of any action hereunder, and shall not, by itself, constitute a breach of fiduciary duty); and to remove property from any such entity; and to give to any such entity, or to any person acting as agent or trustee under any instrument executed by me or on my behalf, such instructions or authorizations as I may have the right to give;

(i) to take all steps and remedies necessary or appropriate for the conduct and management of my business and personal affairs, and for recovering, obtaining and holding all real or personal property including debts, interest, demands, duties, sums of money or any other things whatsoever, as aforesaid, that are thought to be due, owing, belonging or payable to me in my own right or otherwise;

(j) to employ such agents, attorneys, accountants, investment counsel, trustees, caretakers and other persons and entities, and to delegate duties hereunder and pay such compensation, as my agent may deem necessary or appropriate; and

(k) to do, execute, perform and finish for me and in my name all things which my agent shall deem necessary or appropriate, in and about or concerning my property or any part thereof.

In addition, I specifically authorize my agent to deal with tax authorities, to execute and sign on my behalf any and all Federal, state, local and foreign income and gift tax returns, including estimated returns and interest, dividends, gains and transfer returns, for all periods between 1975 and 2050, and to pay any taxes, penalties and interest due thereon; to allocate generation-skipping transfer tax exemptions (within the meaning of Section 2642(a) of the Internal Revenue Code) and to make tax elections; to represent me or to sign an Internal Revenue Service Form 2848 (Power of Attorney or Declaration of Representative) or Form 8821


(Tax Information Authorization), or comparable authorization, appointing a qualified lawyer, certified public accountant or enrolled agent (including my agent if so qualified) to represent me before any office of the Internal Revenue Service or any state, local or foreign taxing authority with respect to the types of taxes and years referred to above, and to specify on said authorization said types of taxes and years; to receive from or inspect confidential information in any office of the Internal Revenue Service or state, local or foreign tax authority; to receive and deposit, in any one of my bank accounts, or those of any revocable trust of mine, checks in payment of any refund of Federal, state, local or foreign taxes, penalties and interest; to pay by check drawn on any bank account of mine or of any revocable trust of mine and have accounts to permit my agent to draw checks for payment of said items; to execute waivers (and offers of waivers) of restrictions on assessment or collection of deficiencies in taxes and waivers of notice of disallowance of a claim for credit or refund; to execute consents extending the statutory period for assessment or collection of such taxes; to execute offers in compromise and closing Agreements under Section 7121 or comparable provisions of the Internal Revenue Code or any Federal, state, local or foreign tax statutes or regulations; to delegate authority or to substitute another representative for any one previously appointed by me or my agent; and to receive copies of all notices and other written communications involving my Federal, state, local or foreign taxes at such address as my agent may designate.

This power of attorney shall not be effective during any period in which I am incapacitated.

This power of attorney, however, shall terminate on January 4, 2006.

To induce any third party to act hereunder, I hereby agree that any third party receiving a duly executed copy or facsimile of this power of attorney may act hereunder, and that revocation or termination hereof shall be ineffective as to such third party unless and until actual notice or knowledge of such revocation or termination shall have been received by such third party. I, for myself and my heirs, executors, legal representatives and assigns, hereby agree to indemnify and hold harmless any such third party from and against any and all claims that may arise against such third party by reason of such third party having relied upon the provisions of this power of attorney.

Also, Federal Law 18 U.S.C. § 922, restricts any person adjudicated as a mental defective or involuntarily committed to any mental institution.



4. Adjudicated delinquent, within the past ten years, for a crime enumerated in Section 6105 of the Uniform Firearms Act, or for an offense under the Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act.
5. Discharged from the Armed Forces of the United States under dishonorable conditions.
6. Under indictment or information in any court for a crime for which the judge could imprison you for more than one year. An information is a formal accusation of a crime made by a prosecuting attorney. An indictment is a formal accusation of a crime presented to the court by a grand jury.
7. Renounced citizenship in the United States.
8. Subject of a court order restraining you from harassing, stalking, or threatening an intimate partner or child of such partner.
9. Convicted in any court of a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence. This includes any misdemeanor conviction involving the use or attempted use of physical force committed by a current or former spouse, parent, or guardian of the victim, or by a person with a similar relationship with the victim.

Section 6105 (a):

Section 6105 (c):

Effective November 22, 1995, 18 Pa.C.S. § 6105 (c) also prohibits the following persons from possessing, using, controlling, transferring, manufacturing, or obtaining a license to possess, use, control, transfer, or manufacture a firearm in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

1. is a fugitive from justice; or

For the purposes of this paragraph only, the prohibition of Section 6105 (a) shall only apply to transfers or purchases of firearms after the third conviction; or
4. has been adjudicated as an incompetent or who has been involuntarily committed to a mental institution for inpatient care and treatment under Section 302, 303 or 304 of the provisions of the act of July 9, 1976 (P.L. 817, No. 143), known as the Mental Health Procedures Act; or
5. being an alien, is illegally or unlawfully in the United States; or
6. is the subject of an active protection from abuse order issued pursuant to 23 Pa.C.S. § 6108 (relating to relief), which order provides for the confiscation of firearms during the period of time the order is in effect. This prohibition shall terminate upon the expiration or vacation of an active protection from abuse order or portion thereof relating to the confiscation of firearms; or
7. was adjudicated delinquent by a court pursuant to 42 Pa.C.S. § 6341 (relating to adjudication) or under any equivalent Federal statute or statute of any other state as a result of conduct which if committed by an adult would constitute an offense under 18 Pa.C.S. Sections 2502, 2503, 2702, 2703, 2704, 2901, 3121, 3123, 3301, 3502, 3701 and 3923; or
8. was adjudicated delinquent by a court pursuant to 42 Pa.C.S. § 6341 or under any equivalent Federal statute or statute of any other state as a result of conduct which if committed by an adult would constitute an offense enumerated in 18 Pa.C.S. § 6105 (b) with the exception of those crimes set forth in paragraph (7). This prohibition shall terminate 15 years after the last applicable delinquent adjudication or upon the person reaching the age of 30, whichever is earlier.

*** The following information refers to situations most often misunderstood regarding denials.

Federal law prohibits a person who is under indictment for, or has been convicted of a crime that would be punishable by a term of imprisonment exceeding one year, or state misdemeanors punishable by a term of imprisonment exceeding two (2) years. The key issue here is the maximum penalty you could have received for the crime; not the actually penalty that you received.
2. There are no time limits on old arrest records. If you have an old conviction for a charge that would be prohibiting, it will still prohibit you regardless of whether the record is one (1) year old or fifty (50) years old.

I am writing this letter upon request of my patient, BRANDON A. LONGE. Mr. Longe has been under my medical care since Nov. 1998. At this point, Mr. Longe suffers from no mental illness. From my review of the records I have in my possession, Mr. Longe has never been diagnosed with, or treated for, a mental illness.

Back in 1998 (when Brandon Longe was 14 years of age) at the time of his three (3) mental health commitments, Mr. Longe's mother was using him by "Munchausen by Proxy". She did this for purposes of getting attention, including medical attention, treatment and prescription medications for herself.

Since Mr. Longe suffers from no mental illness or any other related condition, it is my opinion Mr. Longe may possess, use or control a firearm in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania without any risk to himself or to any other person.





