ROAD VIEWERS.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield in and for said county, on the 15 day of March, A. D. 1869, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Lawrence, in the said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway leading from the Erie Turnpike near the Laurel, ^{Ran} and about one and three quarters miles west of Clearfield Bridge to intersect the road leading to P. Antes near Amos Roads in Lawrence Township

Report as to damages &c

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint W. S. Bigler, Clark Brown and Stewart Read, who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

report; that having given due & public notice of
the time and place of said view as required
by the Act of Assembly we went upon the ground
proposed for said view & having been sworn and
affirmed we examined said road and do now
return for public use the following road to wit
Beginning at the corner road near Amie Read
thence through his lane South 9° East 52 paces
834° East 58 paces thence through wood South
15° East 22 paces thence South 32° East 30 paces
thence South 39° East 20 paces thence South 32° East
4 paces thence South 19° East 10 paces thence South
30° East 44 paces thence South 43° East 27 paces
thence South 36° East 47 paces to the turnpike
which said road we are of opinion is necessary as a pub-
lic road. And we further report no damages
from said view.
