CLEARFIELD COUNTY SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield' in and for said county, on the 15 day of March, A. D. 1869, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the ^{Borough} ~~township~~ of New Washington, in the said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a ^{Change of Street} ~~road~~ or highway leading from Near the M. E. Church in the Borough of New Washington to intersect new Road at the north line of said Borough

Report as to damages &c.

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

S. F. McCloskey, L. S. Horrell, and J. M. Cummings who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

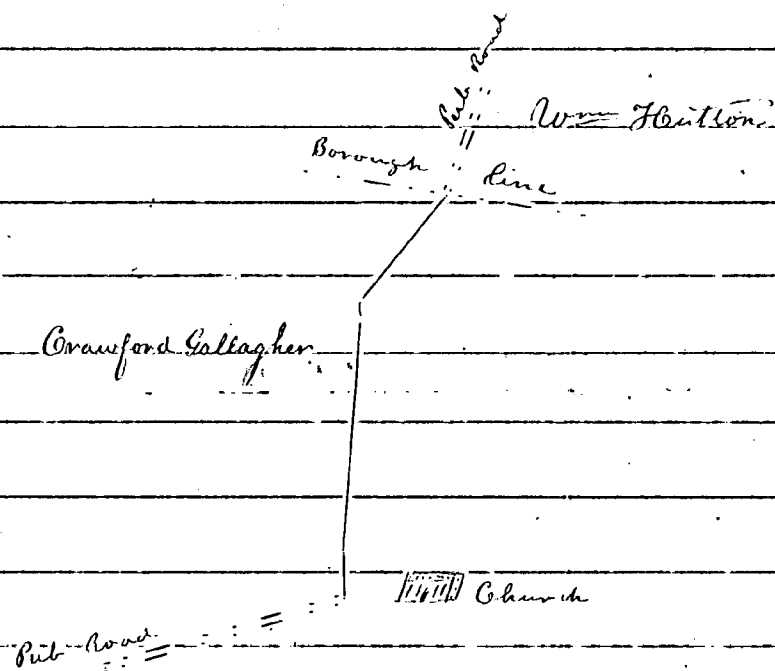

 We the undersigned persons Appointed to, Vacate and
 Supply a Road in the Borough of New Washington, Respectfully
 report That having given notice of the time and place of the view
 of said Road, According to the Act of Assembly, And having all been
 present, At the view of the ground proposed for said Road, and
 having all been first severally sworn in pursuance of the said
 Orders, We have viewed, and laid out, and do return the following
 Road, viz, Beginning at a Post in the Public Road, near the Church
 Thence North Forty two and a half degrees West, Twenty One
 four tenths perches to a Post by the Corner of the Graveyard
 Thence through land of Crawford Gallagher North Thirty seven

degrees West, One hundred and fourteen and five tenths perches to
 a Post near Gallagher's Barn. Thence North Thirty Eight and
 a half West, Two and eight tenths perches. Thence North Two deg
 West, Sixty Six perches to the Borough line and line of
 Wm Hutton. A Draft whereof is herunto annexed.

Which said Road, as aforesaid laid out, we are of opinion
 is necessary for a Public Road, And further, That no
 damage is due to any person, or persons, by the location of the
 aforesaid laid out Road.
