AND NOW, this 25th day of October, 2005, upon consideration of the forgoing

Petition, it is hereby ORDERED that:

1. A Rule is issued upon the Respondent to show cause why the Petitioner is not entitled to the relief requested;
2. The private tax sale scheduled for November 15, 2005, at 9:00 o'clock a.m. in the Tax Claim Bureau, 230 E. Market Street, Clearfield, Pennsylvania, 16830, is STAYED until final determination of Petitioner's claims for relief in the foregoing Petition;
3. The Respondent shall file an Answer to the Petition within twenty (20) days of service upon the Respondent;
4. The Petition shall be decided under Pa. R.C.P. 206.7;
5. An evidentiary hearing on disputed issues of material fact shall be held on the 18th day of November, 2005, at 3:00 o'clock p.m., in Courtroom No. 1, of the Clearfield County Courthouse;
6. Notice of the entry of this Order shall be provided to the Tax Claim Bureau by Christopher E. Mohney, Esquire, counsel for Petitioner, Michael J. McCabe, and on the unknown purchaser by the Tax Claim Bureau.



PETITION FOR STAY OF PRIVATE TAX SALE

AND NOW, comes your Petitioner, MICHAEL J. McCABE, by his attorney, CHRISTOPHER E. MOHNEY, ESQUIRE, and files the following Petition for Stay of Private Tax Sale, and respectfully represents as follows:

1. Michael J. McCabe and Dorothy O. McCabe are the record owners of property identified on the tax rolls as Map No. 7.2-001-000-00179, located in the City of DuBois, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, and being more commonly known as 36-36½-36¾ E. Long Avenue, DuBois, Pennsylvania, 15801.
2. The real estate taxes for the years 2001 through 2004, inclusive are currently owing.
3. The subject property was previously exposed to public tax sale, with no person bidding the upset price.
4. The amount of back taxes currently owing on the property are Ten Thousand Two Hundred Thirty-Seven Dollars Sixty Cents(\$10,237.60).
5. Your Petitioner has been notified by the Tax Claim Bureau that it has received and accepted a bid of Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$4,500.00) for the subject property, for which a private sale has been scheduled for November 15, 2005, at 9:00 o'clock a.m., in the Tax Claim Bureau, 230 E. Market Street, Clearfield, Pennsylvania, 16830.

6. Dorothy O. McCabe is deceased, vesting title to the subject premises in your Petitioner by operation of Pennsylvania law, as a surviving tenant by the entirety.
7. Your Petitioner is prepared to pay the Tax Claim Bureau Ten Thousand Two Hundred Thirty-Seven Dollars Sixty Cents (\$10,237.60), the amount of back taxes due, an amount more than double the private bid accepted by the Tax Claim Bureau.
8. The assessed value of the property on the tax rolls is Fifteen Thousand Six Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$15,650.00).
9. The current common level ratio for Clearfield County from July 1, 2005, through June 30, 2006, is 5.13.
10. The fair market value, based on tax assessed value is Eighty Thousand Two Hundred Eighty-Four Dollars Fifty Cents (\$80,284.50).
11. The Petitioner is prepared to pay all of the back taxes, and Petitioner further respectfully submits that a bid of Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$4,500.00) on a property with a fair market value, by tax assessment calculations, of Eighty Thousand Two Hundred Eighty-Four Dollars Fifty Cents (\$80,284.50) is grossly inadequate and is insufficient as a matter of law.
12. Your Petitioner presently resides in Derry, Pennsylvania, and therefore, has not gotten all necessary notices from the Tax Claim Bureau, or has been unable to pay the tax notices for the reason that your Petitioner is a dentist, but had to prematurely retire from the practice of dentistry by virtue of an arthritic condition in his hands, and your Petitioner has been unable to generate sufficient income to pay the taxes as they become due.


13. Retaining ownership of the subject property at this time is exceedingly important to Petitioner, insofar that Petitioner may be able to utilize the subject property for rental income.

WHEREFORE, your Petitioner respectfully requests that this Honorable Court enter an Order as follows:

1. Staying the private sale proceeding schedule to occur on November 15, 2005, at 9:00 o'clock a.m. in the Tax Claim Bureau, 230 E. Market Street, Clearfield, Pennsylvania, 16830;
2. Schedule an Evidentiary Hearing at which time the Court may accept evidence from the parties in interests; and such other information as the Court may require;
3. Such other relief as this Court deems appropriate.
