10. Defendant has not responded to the Summons and no defense has been entered. Defendants whereabouts are still unknown.




have known that to do so would constitute an unreasonable risk of harm to the general public.

NEW YORK (AP) — The
Kardashian family will continue living
life on TV for the next three years.

The E! Entertainment network said
Tuesday it had reached a deal with its
most bankable franchise to make three
more seasons of "Keeping Up With the
Kardashians."

Terms were not disclosed.

The sixth season of the show aver-
aged three million viewers Sunday
nights, the cable networks' top series.

Five of the 10 most-watched shows
in the network's history, in fact,
involved the Kardashians.

The 18-episode seventh season
begins May 20.

E! said the entire family is covered
