(2). The Respondent, Audrey Boring, is a resident of the City of DuBois, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.

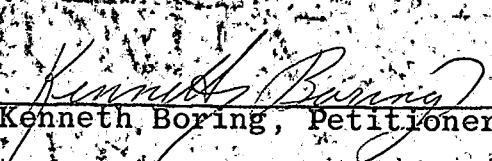
(3). The Respondent, Audrey Boring, has custody of the Petitioner's children as follows:

(5). Your Petitioner is ready, willing and able to provide a good and proper home for said children, and avers their best interests would be served by being placed in his custody.

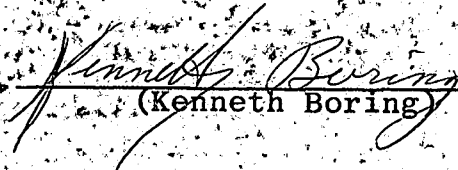

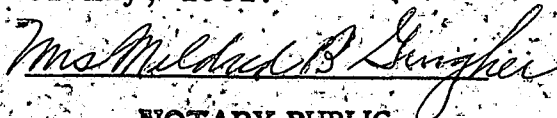

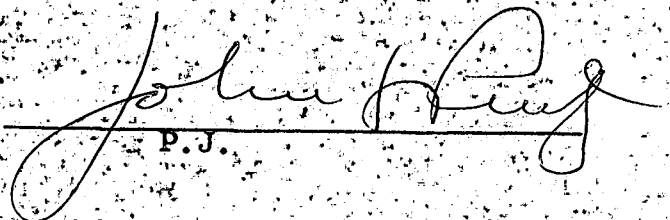
