



And now comes MONTGOMERY WARD & CO. and by its Attorneys, Gleason, Cherry & Cherry, files this Complaint in assumpsit against HAROLD DOKSA and ROSALIE DOKSA, husband and wife, Defendants, upon a cause of action whereof the following is a statement:

1. The Plaintiff, MONTGOMERY WARD & CO. is a business corporation organized and existing under the laws of the United States with a place of business at DuBois, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.
2. The Defendants, HAROLD DOKSA and ROSALIE DOKSA, husband and wife, are individuals and reside at DuBois, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.
3. The Plaintiff, at DuBois, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, at the special instance and request of the Defendants, sold and delivered to the Defendants merchandise, at various times, amounts and kinds.
4. The prices charged for said merchandise are just and reasonable, and are the prices which the Defendants promised to pay Plaintiff for the same.
5. The Plaintiff has demanded payment from the Defendants the amount due of Three Hundred One Dollars and Thirty Nine Cents (\$301.39), but the Defendants have refused and still

refuse to pay the same, or any part thereof since August 16, 1960
the date of Defendants' last payment on said account.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff demands judgment against the
Defendants for the sum of Three Hundred One Dollars and Thirty
Nine Cents (\$301.39), with interest from August 16, 1960.
