NOW COMES, Plaintiffs, Timothy M. Vionito and Jean A. Vionito, husband and wife,  
by and through their attorneys, Hopkins Heltzel LLP and files the within quiet title action and in  
support thereof says as follows:

**COUNT I**

1. Plaintiffs are Timothy M. Vionito and Jean A. Vionito, husband and wife, whose  
address is 467 Treasure Lake, DuBois, Pennsylvania 15801.

2. Defendants are John J. Sestina and Regina A. Sestina whose last known address  
was 1982 Rocklyn Drive, Brunswick, Ohio, 44212. John J. Sestina died April 24, 1991 survived  
by his wife, Defendant, Regina A. Sestina, whose address is unknown.

3. This quiet title action concerns real property known as Section 15, Lot 815 in the  
Treasure Lake Subdivision of Sandy Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania ("the  
Property").

4. By Deed dated August 10, 1970 and recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds in Volume 633 at page 181, Treasure Lake Inc. conveyed the property to Defendants John J. Sestina and Regina A. Sestina

5. Defendants failed to pay real estate taxes assessed against the property. As a result of said failure to pay taxes, the property was turned over to the Tax Claim Bureau of Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, Trustee, under the provision of the Act of July 7, 1947, P.L. 1368, and amendments thereto.

6. By Deed dated December 5, 1994 and recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds in Volume 1649, at page 540, the Tax Claim Bureau of Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, Trustee, under the provision of the Act of July 7, 1947, P.L. 1368, and amendments thereto conveyed the property to Kevin Ferra and Ellen Ferra.

7. By Deed dated April 30, 2001 and recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Clearfield County as Instrument No. 2001-07774, Kevin Ferra and Ellen Ferra, husband and wife, conveyed the property to George R. Moore and Susan B. Moore, husband and wife.

8. By Deed dated March 19, 2002 and recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Clearfield County as Instrument No. 2002-07332, George R. Moore and Susan B. Moore convey the property to Susan B. Moore.

9. By Deed dated September 26, 2005 and recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Clearfield County as Instrument No. 2005-16432, Susan B. Moore conveyed the property to the Plaintiffs, Timothy M. Vionito and Jean A. Vionito.

10. The purpose of this quiet title action is to extinguish for all time any and all rights Defendants, John J. Sestina and Regina A. Sestina, may have in the property.

WHEREFORE, the Plaintiffs request the Court to decree that title to the premises described in paragraph three (3) of the Complaint be granted unto Plaintiffs, Timothy M. Vionito and Jean A. Vionito, in fee simple absolute; and that the Defendants, John J. Sestina and Regina A. Sestina, their heirs, devisees and assigns, all other person, persons, partnerships, limited liability companies or corporate entities in interest, or their legal representatives be forever barred from asserting any right, lien or interest inconsistent with the interest or claim of the Plaintiffs as set forth in and to the property known as Section 15, Lot 815 of the Treasure Lake Subdivision in Sandy Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.
