**APPEAL OF SUSPENSION
OF COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATING PRIVILEGES**

1. Appellant is EDWARD A. WILLIAMS, an individual who resides at 907 Walton Street, Philipsburg, (Chester Hill Borough), Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, 16866.

2. Appellee is Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation, Bureau of Driver Licensing, Citation Processing Division, Room 302, Transportation and Safety Building, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, 17120.

3. Appellant has been notified of the suspension of his driving privileges to drive a commercial motor vehicle as a result of his alleged violation of Title 75 PA.C.S. §3745 (Leaving Scene of Accident) on or about December 11, 2005, copy of said Notice being attached hereto and made a part hereof.

4. The mailing date of said Notice is March 15, 2006.

5. This Court has venue of the instant proceeding as the County of residence of the Appellant.

6. Appellant's privilege to operate a commercial motor vehicle have been suspended, effective April 19, 2006, due to his leaving the scene of an accident on December 11, 2005.

7. Appellant has appealed the suspension of his operator's license and represents to the Court that:

a) The Citation issued to the Appellant (M0859744-4) dated December 12, 2005, identifies the defendant as driving a Ford Station Wagon, registration plate GDA3588, which is a Ford Explorer. This vehicle is a four (4) wheel passenger vehicle, used for Appellant's personal transportation.


b) The suspension of Appellant's commercial driver's license is based on Title 75 §1611(a)(4), which reads as follows:

(4) section 3745 (relating to accidents involving damage to unattended vehicle or property), where the violation occurred while the person was driving a commercial motor vehicle;

8. A copy of the Citation (attached hereto), issued by Terry Jordan, PSP, Badge No. 8108, and the registration of the vehicle will reveal that Appellant was operating a four (4) wheel passenger vehicle, not a commercial motor vehicle.

WHEREFORE, the Appellant prays your Honorable Court for an Order sustaining the Appeal and Dismissing the Suspension of Commercial Motor Vehicle operating privileges.

Dear Motorist:

As a result of your conviction, entry into a pre-adjudication program, or administrative adjudication on 12/21/2005 of violating Section 3745 of the Vehicle Code, LEAVING SCENE OF ACCIDENT on 12/11/2005, your privilege to drive a commercial motor vehicle is being disqualified for a period of 1 YEAR(S) as mandated by Section 1611A of the Vehicle Code.

The effective date of disqualification is 04/19/2006, 12:01 a.m.

In order to comply with this sanction you are required to return any current driver's license, learner's permit and/or temporary driver's license (camera card) in your possession no later than the effective date listed. If you cannot comply with the requirements stated above, you are required to submit a DL16LC Form or a sworn affidavit stating that you are aware of the sanction against your driving privilege. Failure to comply with this notice shall result in this Bureau referring this matter to the Pennsylvania State Police for prosecution under SECTION 1571(a)(4) of the Vehicle Code.

Although the law mandates that your driving privilege is under suspension even if you do not surrender your license, Credit will not begin until all current driver's license product(s), the DL16LC Form, or a letter acknowledging your sanction is received in this Bureau.

WHEN THE DEPARTMENT RECEIVES YOUR LICENSE OR ACKNOWLEDGEMENT, WE WILL SEND YOU A RECEIPT. IF YOU DO NOT RECEIVE THIS RECEIPT WITHIN 15 DAYS CONTACT THE DEPARTMENT IMMEDIATELY. OTHERWISE, YOU WILL NOT BE GIVEN CREDIT TOWARD SERVING THIS SANCTION.

While your commercial driving privilege is disqualified, the Vehicle Code permits a driver to obtain a noncommercial Class C or M license, if the driver possesses the motorcycle qualification, to drive noncommercial motor vehicles. If you wish to obtain this license, please complete the enclosed application as instructed and return it to the Department.

Please be aware that if you elect to obtain this noncommercial Class C or M license, you are still prohibited from operating a commercial motor vehicle. If you do so, you are subject to additional penalties, including possible lifetime disqualification of your commercial driving privilege.

You have the right to appeal the Department's action to the Court of Common Pleas (Civil Division) within 30 days of the mail date (MARCH 15, 2006) of this notice. You must still send in your license before the effective date of disqualification unless you appear in person before a Judge and receive an order permitting you to continue to drive. PLEASE NOTE that this Civil Appeal is in addition to any appeal you have to file from the criminal conviction.
