

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DECLARATION OF TAKING (D.T. Mitchell, Jr. Property)

AND NOW COMES THE CONDEMNOR, Cambria County Conservation & Recreation Authority, by and through its attorney, and hereby declares that:

1. Condemnor is the Cambria County Conservation & Recreation Authority, a municipal authority organized and existing under the Pennsylvania Municipal Authorities Act of 1945, 53 P.S. Section 306. The address of Condemnor is 401 Candlelight Drive, Suite 234, Ebensburg, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, 15931.

2. This condemnation is authorized under Section 4 of the Municipal Authorities Act of 1945, as amended (53 P.S. Section 306).

3. This Declaration of Taking was authorized by the Board of the Cambria County Conservation & Recreation Authority at its regular monthly meeting. A record of said authorization may be examined by reviewing the approved minutes of the meeting at the address for the Cambria County Conservation & Recreation Authority listed above.

4. The purpose of this condemnation is to acquire the property in order to remediate acid mine drainage on the site and construct a recreational facility primarily for motorized uses. The public need thereby served is the treatment of the discharge of acid mine drainage that is polluting the water tables and water sheds of Rock Run, as well as providing recreational and economic opportunities for that region.


5. The property described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof, now owned by the County National Bank, Trustee for the Estate of D.T. Mitchell, Jr. and heirs, which is a 1/6th interest in the property described in deed recorded in the Clearfield County Recorder of Deeds Office on August 7, 1967 in Deed Book Volume 591 at page 183, is hereby CONDEMNED. Said property consists of one sixty acre parcel of land. Plans showing the property condemned are this day being lodged for record in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds in Clearfield County, Pennsylvania in accordance with Section 404 of the Eminent Domain Code.

6. A plan showing the condemned property may be inspected at the Cambria County Conservation & Recreation Authority at 401 Candlelight Drive, Suite 234, Ebensburg, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, 15931.

7. Condemnor is taking the following estate in the property: Fee simple absolute, excepting and reserving any and all mineral rights reserved in Condemnee by prior instruments of conveyance.

8. Just compensation has been made or secured by the filing of the Bond of the Authority, attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "B" for the use and benefit of the owner or the owners of the property in interest, a condition of which the Condemnor shall pay such amount of damages as the said owner or owners of the properties and other parties in interest shall be entitled to receive by reason of such condemnation, after the same shall have been agreed upon or assessed in the manner provided by law.
