The petition of the undersigned,

~~Respectfully represents that they~~
are taxable inhabitants of the Township
of Morris, in said County of Clearfield,
and desire the formation of the territory
on which they reside, into a separate
and independent School District, as
follows, viz, Commencing at S.W. corner Fred

Hubley, thence South along tract to corner of Mathias Slough thence East to corner of

Tris Hubley & Dr Hubley, excluding Wm Rothrock farm thence along line between

Habaker & Dr Hubley to corner of Habacker thence east to Peter Yamell tract

thence South corner Robt Glenn thence S. E. to Moshamon Creek thence

Creek S. W. to mouth Emigh Run thence up run to line of Wm Shultz

thence across Wm Shultz & Chas Witz to line of Philip Stone thence

west along line of Philip Stone for enough so that a line running north will
strike the place of beginning

The petitioners therefore showing that they
are not less than twenty of the taxable
inhabitants of the said Township of Morris
and that such independent School dis-
trict will protect and promote the
educational welfare in such locality,
which is not now properly provided for
under the Organization of the School
District of the said Township of Morris,
That at the Morrisdale Mines, in the

Centre of the proposed independent District there are seventy children who are deprived of the benefit of Common Schools.

Your petitioners therefore pray the Court to appoint Commissioners to view the premises and report to this Court at the next term thereof, the lines of the proposed new district either according to the bounds hereinbefore set forth, or according to such other bounds as said Commissioners shall think more advisable, together with their opinion of the expediency of establishing or not establishing the same.

1. Because it does not appear by
the report viewed the premises, as re-
quired by law, they do not allege that
they made any view or examination of
the premises, but report the boundaries
set forth in the petition.
2. Because it does not appear
by the report of the Commissioners
that they gave notice of the time
and place of meeting, or that
any such notice was given
nor does it appear by the report
~~that they did meet for the~~
purpose of viewing the premises.
3. The Commissioners do not report
that it is expedient to establish
said district.
4. The Commissioners do not at-
tain such a draft as is re-
quired by law, to show the location
of the proposed district in said
township, ~~attached~~ the draft at-
tached hereto was not made
by said Commissioners, and no ref-
erence is made to the same by them
nor is the said draft in any man-
ner by them authenticated.

North along the line between the said Hubley
and Henry Brinkers to the North West Corner
of the said Frederick Hubley Tracts from
thence nearly East along the line of said
Hubley to the North West Corner of the
J^r. Hubley Tracts ^{Excluding William's & Thomas's farm} from thence, due East
along the line of said J^r. Hubley Tracts to
the line of the Philip Wagoner Tracts from
thence ~~due~~ South along the line of the
said J^r. Hubley and Geo. Metzger Tracts to
the South East Corner of the Geo. Habaker
