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**COMPLAINT IN A CIVIL ACTION**

AND NOW COME Alfred F. Jasmin and Rita Jasmin, by their Attorney James D.

Belliveau to file this complaint and to set forth in support thereof the following:

1. Plaintiffs Alfred F. Jasmin and Rita Jasmin, husband and wife, are adult individuals residing at 63 Sundance Drive, Effort Monroe County, Pennsylvania County 18330.
2. Defendant Sheetz, Inc., is a Pennsylvania Corporation with a place of business located at 1867 Rich Highway, Falls Creek, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania 15840.
3. Defendant Sheetz, Inc. operates a convenience store and gas station at this address.
4. On November 26, 2004, Plaintiff Alfred F. Jasmin entered onto the premises of the Sheetz Convenience store and gas station at the above location with the purpose of purchasing gasoline. He pulled his vehicle up adjacent to one of the islands where the gas pumps are located, opened the door to his truck and began to descend. When his feet came into contact with the surface of the parking lot, he was caused to slip, trip, stumble and/or fall as a result of an artificial accumulation of pooled gasoline on the

surface of the parking lot. As a result of this slip, trip, stumble, and/or fall, Plaintiff Alfred F. Jasmin has suffered serious and permanent injuries.

5. The above described accident occurred as a direct and proximate result of the negligence of the Defendant Sheetz, Inc. by or through the acts or omissions of its agents, officers or employees while within the course and scope of their employment in the following particulars:
  - a. In failing to inspect the premises to discover the existence of the accumulated pool of gasoline.
  - b. In failing to take steps to clean up the accumulated pool of gasoline.
  - c. In failing to put some type of anti-slip material in the accumulated pool of gasoline.
  - d. In failing to warn customers such as Alfred F. Jasmin of the existence of the accumulated pool of gasoline;
  - e. In causing or allowing the accumulated pool of gasoline to remain on the surface of the parking lot when Defendant's agents, officers and employees knew or should have known in the exercise of reasonable care that it presented a hazard to patrons such as Alfred F. Jasmin; and
  - f. In breaching the high duty of care owed to Plaintiff Alfred F. Jasmin as a business invitee.
6. In addition to the vicarious liability of the Defendants Sheetz Inc. for the acts and omissions of its agents, officers, and employees, Defendants Sheetz Inc. is independently liable for its negligence in the following particulars:




- a. In failing to hire, train and supervise employees who were taught how to deal with accumulated pools of gasoline;
  - b. In failing to have in place policies and procedures regarding regular inspections of its premises so as to discover hazards present on the premises by items such as an accumulated pool;
  - c. In failing to have in place appropriate gasoline pumps so that there would be no spill of gasoline which would allow pools of gasoline to accumulate;
  - d. In having a surface of the pavement which would become too slippery when gasoline pooled on it;
  - e. In failing to take the steps to warn patrons such as Alfred F. Jasmin of the possibility that accumulated pools of gasoline may exist;
  - f. In failing to have a sufficient number of employees on duty so that regular and thorough inspections of the premises could be made to discover hazards such as accumulated pools of gasoline and so that such hazards could be eliminated, cordoned off and/or warned about.
7. As a direct and proximate result of the negligence of the Defendant Sheetz Inc., Plaintiff Alfred F. Jasmin suffered the following injuries:
- i. Mixed motor sensory polyneuropathy with predominantly demyelinating change;
  - ii. Chronic denervation in the L4-5, S1 distribution consistent with chronic lumbar polyradiculopathy;
  - iii. Dorsal lumbar injury;
  - iv. Lumbar radiculopathy on the left;

- v. Aggravation of a pre-existing condition of his lumbar spine;
  - vi. Severe shock, strain, or sprain to the nerves, muscles, tissues, and ligaments of his muscular skeletal system.
8. As a direct and proximate result of the negligence of the Defendant Sheetz Inc., set forth as above, Plaintiff Alfred F. Jasmin has been damaged as follows;
- a. He has endured and continues to endure pain, suffering inconvenience and loss of enjoyment of life;
  - b. His general health, strength and vitality have been impaired;
  - c. He has been surgically scarred;
  - d. He has incurred medical expense in excess of the available first party medical benefits;
  - e. He may incur additional medical expenses in the future;
  - f. He has lost wages
  - g. He has been embarrassed and humiliated.
9. As a direct and approximate result of negligence of the Defendants Sheetz Inc., as set forth above, Plaintiff Rita Jasmin has been damaged by the loss of the consortium of her husband Plaintiff Alfred F. Jasmin.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiffs Alfred F. Jasmin and Rita Jasmin demand judgment against Defendant Sheetz Inc. for an amount in excess of the statutory arbitration limits.

A JURY TRIAL IS DEMANDED.





4. The allegations contained in Paragraph 4 of Plaintiffs' Complaint are conclusions of law to which no response is required. To the extent a response is deemed necessary, said allegations are denied and strict proof thereof is demanded at the time of trial.

5. The allegations contained in Paragraph 5, including subparagraphs (a) through (f) of Plaintiffs' Complaint are conclusions of law to which no response is required. To the extent a response is deemed necessary, said allegations are denied and strict proof thereof is demanded at the time of trial.

6. The allegations contained in Paragraph 6, including subparagraphs (a) through (f), of Plaintiffs' Complaint are conclusions of law to which no response is required. To the extent a response is deemed necessary, said allegations are denied and strict proof thereof is demanded at the time of trial.

7. The allegations contained in Paragraph 7, including subparagraphs (i) through (vi), of Plaintiffs' Complaint are conclusions of law to which no response is required. To the extent a response is deemed necessary, said allegations are denied and strict proof thereof is demanded at the time of trial.

8. The allegations contained in Paragraph 8, including subparagraphs (a) through (g), of Plaintiffs' Complaint are conclusions of law to which no response is required. To the extent a response is deemed necessary, said allegations are denied and strict proof thereof is demanded at the time of trial.

9. The allegations contained in Paragraph 9 of Plaintiffs' Complaint are conclusions of law to which no response is required. To the extent a response is deemed necessary, said allegations are denied and strict proof thereof is demanded at the time of trial.

WHEREFORE, Defendant Sheetz, respectfully requests that this Court enter judgment in its favor and against Plaintiffs, Alfred F. Jasmin and Rita Jasmin, including interest, costs and other damages this Court deems appropriate.

**NEW MATTER**

10. Paragraphs 1 through 9 of Sheetz, Inc.'s Answer are incorporated herein by reference.

11. To the extent the discovery discloses that Plaintiffs were contributorily and/or comparatively negligent at the time and place of the alleged injury, Defendant, Sheetz, Inc., pleads such contributory and/or comparative negligence as a complete bar to or in diminution of Plaintiffs' claims.

12. To the extent that discovery discloses that Plaintiffs' alleged injuries and/or damages are the result of the intervening or superseding actions of third parties or individuals over whom Defendant, Sheetz, Inc., had no control, Defendant pleads same as a complete bar to Plaintiffs' claims.

13. To the extent applicable, Defendant, Sheetz, Inc., pleads Plaintiffs' failure to mitigate their damages as a partial bar to the entirety of Plaintiffs' claims.

14. To the extent discovery discloses that Plaintiffs' alleged damages were the result of Plaintiffs' pre-existing conditions, Defendant, Sheetz, Inc., pleads such condition as a bar to Plaintiffs' claims.

15. Defendant, Sheetz, Inc., pleads all applicable statute of limitations as a bar to Plaintiffs' claims.

16. Plaintiff's Complaint fails to state a claim for which relief can be granted.


17. To the extent discovery discloses that existence of gasoline at the site of the alleged incident, which is denied, Sheetz, Inc. pleads such as an open and obvious condition.

**MOTION TO COMPEL DISCOVERY RESPONSES FROM PLAINTIFFS**

AND NOW, comes Defendant, Sheetz, Inc. ("Sheetz"), by its attorneys, Dickie, McCamey & Chilcote, P.C., and submits the within Motion to Compel:

1.      On or about March 11, 2006, the Defendant Sheetz served Plaintiffs with its First Set of Interrogatories and Request for Production of Documents. (A true and correct copy of the Notice of Service is attached hereto as Exhibit "A.")

2.      On or about November 6, 2006, the Plaintiffs' served their Answers To Interrogatories and Responses to Requests for Production of Documents on Sheetz. (A true and correct copy of the Answers and Responses are attached hereto as Exhibit "B.")

3.      Sheetz' Request for Production of Document number 3 asked plaintiffs to produced,

[A]ny and all letters, medical records or reports which you, or anyone acting on your behalf, have obtained from the hospitals, doctors or radiologists identified in your answers to defendant's interrogatories. In the alternative, if you are not in possession of the requested documents, please execute the enclosed authorization for release of records with the understanding that copies of any documents obtained through the use of the authorization will be provided to your attorney upon request.

4. In their answers to interrogatories, Plaintiffs identified the following medical providers: Dr. James Kerrigan, Dr. Casey Lee, St. Barnabus Hospital, Pocono Medical Center, Dr. Martin Sorger, Mountainside Hospital, Dr. Gerald Zupruk, Leighigh Valley Neurosurgery, St. Lukes Hospital, Riverside Rehabilitation Center, Dr. William Martucci, Bruce Snyder, M.S., and Dr. Yasin Khan. *See* Exhibit "B", Plaintiffs' Answers to Interrogatories number ten (10), eleven (11) and twelve (12).

5. Plaintiffs have provided Sheetz with records from Dr. Khan, Bruce Snyder, M.S., Dr. Kerrigan (from January 1, 2003 through present for low back injury only), St. Lukes Hospital (1/26/06 and 2/27/06 admissions), Dr. Martucci (March 7, 2000 through September 15, 2006), Dr. Lee (April 8, 2003 through January 10, 2005), and St. Barnabus Hospital (operative report from April 8, 2003).

6. Plaintiffs' Response to Request for Production of Documents indicate that they were also producing records from Riverside Rehabilitation Center. *See* Exhibit "B", Plaintiffs' Response to Request number three (3). The only documents produced from Riverside Rehabilitation Center were the letters from plaintiffs' counsel's office requesting records, as well as the initial evaluation report and the discharge summary, which were included in Dr. Kerrigan's records.

7. Plaintiffs have not provided Sheetz with any records from St. Luke's Hospital and Dr. Zupruk relating to plaintiff's October 1998 cervical fusion surgery, or a complete set of records from St. Barnabus Hospital relating to an April 2003 surgery.

8. Plaintiffs referenced a 1980 lumbar surgery and indicated that they were seeking information regarding this surgery. *See* Exhibit "B", Plaintiffs' Answer to Interrogatory number eleven (11). To date, no information has been provided to Defendant regarding this surgery.

9. Mixed throughout the records from Dr. Kerrigan are a few incomplete records from Pocono Medical Center dated March 2003, Dr. Sorger and/or Mountainside Hospital regarding an October 1994 laminectomy, and Dr. Gerald Zupruk and/or Leigh Valley Neurosurgery from October 1998.

10. In a March 10, 2007 e-mail between defense counsel and plaintiffs' counsel defense counsel requested copies of all of plaintiff-husband's medical records. (A true and correct copy of the March 10, 2007 e-mail is attached hereto as Exhibit "C.")

11. To date, Plaintiffs have not yet fully responded to the discovery requests by providing records for all the providers cited in their responses, by signing an authorization to allow Sheetz to procure the records, nor by supplementing their responses by producing additional documents as indicated.

WHEREFORE, the Defendant Sheetz, Inc., request this Court to enter the attached Order requiring Plaintiff to fully answer and supplement their answers to the Interrogatories and Requests for Production of Documents within 30 days.
