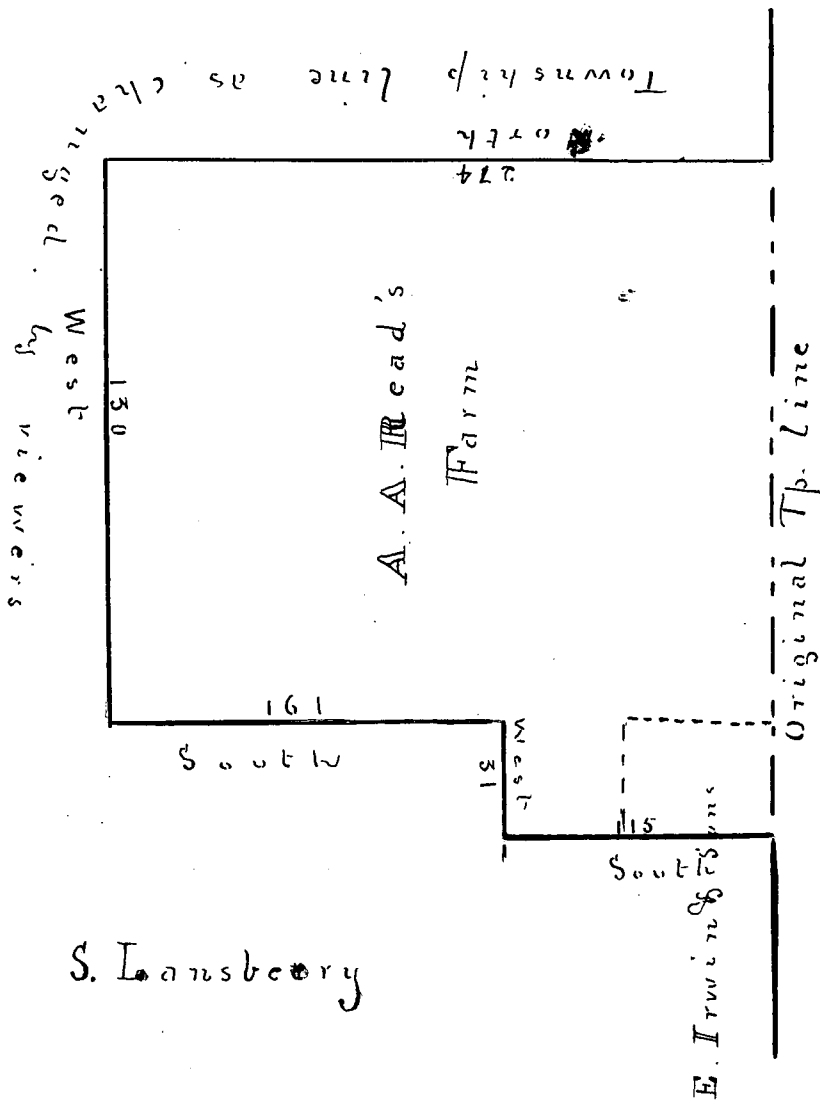

ROAD VIEWER'S REPORT.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 8th day of November, A. D., 1868, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Lawrence, in the said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a ~~road or highway~~ ^{change of the township} ~~leading from~~ since between Lawrence and Graham except for school purposes. Beginning at the North corner of land of Alex. Reed in Graham Township. Thence South to land of H. B. Burdick, thence South to land of Samuel Danbury, thence South to Danbury line.

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and ^{change} ~~lay out~~ the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint W. Q. Rider, Jas. Conway and George Mannion.

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for ^{change} ~~said road~~ and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such ^{change} ~~road~~ they shall proceed to ^{change} ~~lay out~~ the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, ~~having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public purpose~~ ^{road}, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

The undersigned persons appointed by the said Courts to view the Township lines between Lawrence & Goshen Townships in accordance with the order of said Court respectfully report:

That having given due and public notice of said view by printed notice. They met at the time and place appointed, and having been sworn & affirmed, they viewed the premises and the draft and lines sent, & they are of opinion that the Township line between Lawrence & Goshen Townships should be changed for all purposes except School purposes, as follows: Beginning at the South East corner of land of A. A. Reed on Township line thence North 274 perches to land formerly Ellen Reed, thence West 130 perches to Hemlock, thence South 161 perches to post, thence West 31 perches to Hemlock, thence South 115 perches to Township line a draft or plot whereof is hereto annexed which said change we report as necessary.
