TO THE HONORABLE JOHN J. PENTZ, PRESIDENT JUDGE OF THE SAID COURT:

The Petition of Steven Jay Kuntz, by Lienhard Kuntz and Theresa Kuntz, his natural guardians, respectfully represents:

1. That your Petitioner is a minor, having been born on January 22, 1942 and being presently nineteen (19) years of age. This Petition is presented on his behalf by his parents and natural guardians, Lienhard Kuntz and Theresa Kuntz.

2. That your Petitioner is a resident of the said County and resides in Ramey, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania; having resided continuously in Clearfield County for the last eighteen (18) years.

3. That your Petitioner desires to have his name changed to Steven Jay Koontz for the following reasons:

a. That your Petitioner has experienced difficulties, inconvenience and suffered great embarrassment at school and elsewhere as a result of the difficulties in the pronunciation of his name.

b. That the said difficulties, inconvenience and embarrassment has become more pronounced since his entry into classes at Pennsylvania State University so that matters have reached a point where it is a continuous topic of conversation and source of continuous jokes among fellow classmates.

c. That your Petitioner feels that with the change of spelling of the said name there would be no reasons for mispronunciation or misinterpretation thereof and would eliminate these continuous sources of embarrassment.

4. This Petition is consented to and joined in by the parents as is evidenced by the Consent and Joinder attached hereto and made a part hereof.

5. That your Petitioner has tried to live with this situation as long as possible and has endeavored in every way to correct it in other manners, but has been unsuccessful in doing so.

6. That there are no judgments or decrees of like character against your Petitioner.

WHEREFORE, your Petitioner prays the Court to enter a Decree changing his name from Steven Jay Kuntz to Steven Jay Koontz.
