

COMPLAINT IN PARTITION

AND NOW, comes the Plaintiffs, LAWRENCE P. DOMAN and ELMA J. DOMAN, husband and wife, by and through their attorney David R. Thompson, Esquire, who file the following Complaint in Partition of which the following is averred::

1. The Plaintiffs are LAWRENCE P. DOMAN and ELMA J. DOMAN, husband and wife, who has an address of 3500 Blackburn Road, Houtzdale, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, 16651.

2. The Defendant is DORIS J. DOMAN, an individual, who has an address of 143 Pine Street, Houtzdale, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, 16651.

3. The parties are the joint owners of a parcel of real property located in the Borough of Houtzdale, County of Clearfield, Pennsylvania, previously assessed in the name of Andrew Domen a/k/a Andrew Doman.

4. The parties are heirs of the said Andrew Domen a/k/a Andrew Doman, and are successors in interest of the said real property, as more particularly described herein.

5. The real property was vested in the said Andrew Domen a/k/a Andrew Doman by

deed dated February 14, 1907 and recorded in the Clearfield County Recorder's Office in Deed Book No. 168 at Page 222, more particularly described as follows:

ALL that interest in that certain lot or piece of ground situate in the Borough of Houtzdale, County of Clearfield and State of Pennsylvania, described as follows:

BEGINNING on the Northwest corner of Don Street and Squirrel Alley, running along said alley, North seventy eight and one half degrees West, One Hundred and Fifty (150) feet to Charles Street; thence along the said Street South eleven and one half degrees West fifty (50) feet to a post; thence South seventy eight and one half degrees East one hundred and fifty (150) feet to Don Street; thence along said Street North eleven and one half degrees East, fifty (50) feet to a post at the place of beginning and known as lot No. 404 in the general plan of the said Borough.

EXCEPTING AND RESERVING, NEVERTHELESS, all the stone, coal and other minerals underlying the said described premises with the right to mine and remove the same, and all rights excepted and reserved in the deed from Houtz Heirs to William Wynn, recorded in the Recorder's office of Clearfield County.

6. Plaintiffs Lawrence P. Doman and Elma J. Doman are the owners of a Five-Sixth (5/6th) interest in the real property by virtue of a deed dated April 27, 2006 and recorded in the Clearfield County Recorder's Office as Instrument Number 200607093.

7. Defendant Doris J. Doman is the owner of a One-Sixth (1/6th) interest in the real property as the sole remaining heir of the said Andrew Doman a/k/a Andrew Doman who has not relinquished her interest, as more particularly averred herein.

8. The said Andrew Doman died on December 7, 1955 intestate, and no estate has been opened for that individual. By way of further pleading, the property has remained

unoccupied and in poor condition.

9. At the time of his death, the heirs at law of Andrew Doman a/k/a Andrew Doman were his children; to wit: Mary Mirkin, John A. Doman, Sophia Doman, Catherine Doman, Andrew J. Doman, Lawrence Doman, (Plaintiff herein), Joseph F. Doman, Dorothy Doman and Thomas L. Doman. By way of further pleading, Doris J. Doman is the spouse of Joseph F. Doman.

10. The said John A. Doman died January 21, 1967, leaving to survive him, his wife Elizabeth Doman, who died September 8, 2002, and his children Robert Doman, Frederick Doman, Elizabeth Semler, and John A. Doman, Jr. The said John A. Doman, Jr. died on July 13, 1997, leaving to survive him, his wife Theresa Doman, and his children Randall Doman, Terry Kirkpatrick, Trudy Doman, and Tracy Kranik.

11. The said Mary Mirkin died on July 3, 1976, a widow with no children. Her heirs at law were her siblings and/or their respective surviving heirs.

12. The said Catherine Doman died on May 3, 1980, a single individual with no children. Her heirs at law were her siblings and/or their respective surviving heirs.

13. The said Andrew L. Doman died on November 5, 1992, a single individual with no children. His heirs at law were his siblings and/or their respective surviving heirs.

14. The said Sophia Doman died on May 29, 1997, a single individual with no children. Her heirs at law were her siblings and/or their respective surviving heirs.

15. The said Thomas L. Doman died on September 1, 2001, a widower with no children. His heirs at law were his siblings and/or their respective surviving heirs.

16. The said Joseph F. Doman died on April 25, 2004, leaving to survive him, his wife Doris J. Doman (Defendant) and son Joseph Doman.

17. The said Dorothy Doman Rothwell died on June 20, 2005, a single individual with no children. Her heirs at law were her siblings and/or their respective surviving heirs.

18. At the time of the said Andrew Doman a/k/a Andrew Doman's death, his children each owned a One-Ninth (1/9th) interest in the real property.

19. As of September 25, 2005, the heirs at law of John A. Doman (referenced in Paragraph 10 herein) collectively owned a One-third (1/3rd) interest in the real property.

20. As of September 25, 2005, the heirs at law of Joseph F. Doman (referenced in Paragraph 16 herein) collectively owned a One-third (1/3rd) interest in the real property. Specifically, Doris J. Doman (Defendant) and Joseph Doman each owned a One-Sixth (1/6th) interest.

21. As of September 25, 2005, Plaintiff Lawrence Doman owned a One-Third (1/3rd) interest in the real property.

22. By deed dated September 26, 2005 and recorded in the Clearfield County Recorder's Office as Instrument Number 200607092, the heirs at law of John A. Doman, together with their spouses, conveyed their interest in the real property unto the Plaintiffs.

23. By deed dated October 21, 2005 and recorded in the Clearfield County Recorder's Office as Instrument Number 200607091, the said Joseph Doman, together with his spouse, conveyed his One-Sixth (1/6th) interest in the real property unto the Plaintiffs.

24. By virtue of their deed referenced in Paragraph 6 herein, Plaintiffs are the owners of a Five-Sixth (5/6th) interest in the real property.

25.. Doris J. Doman, by virtue of the laws of intestacy, remains the owner of a One-Sixth (1/6th) interest in the said real property.

26. Plaintiffs have been in the actual physical possession of the said real property since

approximately June of 2005, maintaining the structures and real property to the best of their ability.

27. There exists no mortgages or judgment liens against the real property that appear of record, and no person or persons other than those above mentioned have an interest in the real property.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiffs respectfully request:

1. That a Partition of the said real property be made according to the rights of the respective parties hereto; and if a partition cannot be had without material injury to those rights, then that said premises be sold and the proceeds be applied in the following order:
 - a. To the payment of the general costs of this action;
 - b. To the costs of reference, if any, including attorney's fees; and
 - c. To the Plaintiffs and Defendant in proportion to their respective interests.
2. Any other relief that the Court deems appropriate.
