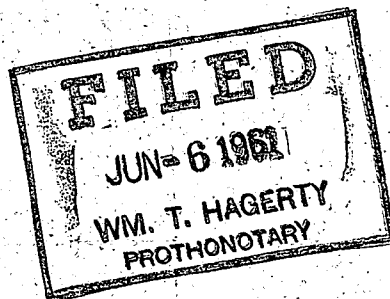

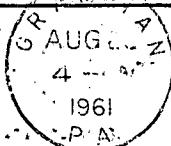

NOW, to wit, this 24 day of May, 1961,
the Plaintiff, by his attorney, Edward T. Kelley, Esquire,
brings this action to trespass against the defendant to re-
cover \$166.06.

1. The Plaintiff is William E. Reid who is engaged
in business in DuBois, Pennsylvania, doing business as DuBois
News Distributors with place of business at DuBois, Pennsylvania.

2. The defendant is Leo Quigley of Grampain, Penn-
sylvania.

3. On the 5th day of March, 1961, at or about 12:20
A. M. the plaintiff's 1960 Chevrolet one ton quarter truck was
being driven by the Plaintiff's agent, servant, and employee,
George W. Clark, also of DuBois, Pennsylvania.

4. At a point off the highway in front of Fairlawn
Grocery Store and completely off the berm, George W. Clark
had parked the truck and was opening the back doors in order
to unload part of his delivery.

5. At said time and place, George W. Clark saw
headlights coming toward him for a car that negligently and
carelessly shot through a stop sign, came over to the wrong
side of the highway, and struck the right rear door and rear
quarter panel of Plaintiff's truck and then kept going and
disappeared. The driver was Leo Rafferty.

6. The negligence and carelessness of the defen-
dant was in going too fast under the circumstances, being on
the wrong side of the road, and failing to stop at the stop
sign.

7. As a result of the defendant's negligence, the truck of the plaintiff was greatly damaged as outlined above so that repairs to the said plaintiff's truck amounted to \$166.06.

8. Wherefore plaintiff claims he has suffered damages to the extent of \$166.06 with interest from the fifth day of March 1961.

Hence this suit.
