**PETITION TO APPEAL SUSPENSION
OF DRIVER'S LICENSE**

NOW COMES, Petitioner, Mary Frailey, by and through her Attorney, Paul Colavecchi, Esquire, files this Petition to Appeal Suspension of Driver's License and respectfully avers as follows:

1. Petitioner, Mary Frailey, by letter dated September 23, 2006, received notice that her privilege to operate a motor vehicle is being suspended as of October 14, 2006, a copy of said letter being attached hereto marked Exhibit "A".

2. The reason given for the suspension of driving privileges is that the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation, had received medical information indicating that Petitioner had a seizure disorder condition which prevents her from safely operating a motor vehicle.

3. Pursuant to said letter, Petitioner's driving privileges have been recalled indefinitely as mandated by Section 1519(c) of


the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code, said Section titled, Termination of Competency.

4. Petitioner contends that she was examined at the DuBois Regional Medical Center by Dr. Phuong Wirths on September 11, 2006, due to the fact that she went to the Emergency Room after a very bad panic attack and was referred to Dr. Phuong Wirths. She was not diagnosed by Dr. Wirths as having a seizure disorder condition. The assessment by Dr. Wirth was set forth as depression with anxiety and insomnia, which was situationally induced. A copy of said medical report is attached hereto and marked Exhibit "B."

5. Petitioner is aggrieved at this time by the suspension of her driver's privileges because it is her only means of transportation.

6. Petitioner contends that the Commonwealth has not met its burden of proof in making a determination of incompetence so that her driving privilege should be suspended indefinitely.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner prays that your Honorable Court grant this Appeal and after a hearing on the merits and reverse said suspension.

Dear Ms. MARY FRAILEY:

We have received medical information indicating that you have Psychiatric and Seizure Disorder conditions which prevents you from safely operating a motor vehicle.

As of 10/14/2006, you may no longer drive. Your driving privilege is hereby recalled indefinitely as mandated by Section 1519(c) of the Vehicle Code.

This decision has been made by comparing your medical condition with the standards recommended by our Medical Advisory Board and adopted by this Department. This action will remain in effect until we receive medical information that your condition has improved and you are able to safely operate a motor vehicle.

In order to comply with this action, you must return all current Pennsylvania driver's licenses, learner's permits, temporary driver's licenses (camera cards) in your possession on or before the effective date listed above. If you cannot comply with the requirements stated above, a sworn affidavit stating that you are aware of the sanction against your driving privilege must be submitted. When the Department receives your license or affidavit, we will send you a receipt.

If you do not return all current driver license products, we must refer this matter to the Pennsylvania State Police for prosecution under SECTION 1571 (a) (4) of the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code.

YOU MAY NOT RETAIN YOUR DRIVER'S LICENSE FOR IDENTIFICATION PURPOSES. However, you may apply for and obtain a photo identification card at any Driver License Center.

You have the right to appeal to the Court of Common Pleas (Civil Division) within thirty (30) days of the mail date of this notice. If you file an appeal in the County Court, the Court will give you a time-stamped certified copy of the appeal. In order for your appeal to be valid, you must send this time-stamped copy of the appeal by certified mail to:

You still must send in your license before the effective date of recall unless you appear in person before a judge and receive an order permitting you to continue driving.

1. Petitioner is Mary Frailey having a mailing address of P.O. Box 709, Drifting, Pennsylvania 16834.

2. Petitioner was notified by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation, by letter dated September 23, 2006, that her driving privileges are being suspended as of October 14, 2006.

3. The Commonwealth cited that medical information had been received which indicated that Petitioner has a seizure disorder condition which prevents her from safely operating a motor vehicle.

4. Petitioner has filed an Appeal on this date, and has alleged that she has not been diagnosed with a seizure disorder condition and has never seen any medical documentation that sets forth any such condition.

Further, Petitioner alleged that she has been treated by Dr. Phuong Wirths of the DuBois Regional Medical Center for a very bad


panic attack but was not diagnosed with a seizure disorder condition. On the contrary, the assessment was depression with anxiety and insomnia, situationally induced. A copy of said medical report being attached hereto marked Exhibit "A".

Petitioner requests at this time that a supersedes be entered so that she may operate her motor vehicle pending a hearing on the Appeal of her Driver's License Suspension.

6. Petitioner files this Petition for a hearing pursuant to Section 1550 of the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code which sets for that an Appeal shall not act as a supercedes if the suspension is based on reasons set forth in Section 1519.

7. Section 1550 sets forth that the Appeal shall not act as a supercedes unless Ordered by the Court after hearing attended by Petitioner.

8. Petitioner requests that the Court conduct a hearing and determine whether a supercedes can be entered so that Petitioner can operate a motor vehicle pending the Appeal.
