3. Defendant applied for and received a credit card bearing the account number 4121741667375732 .


4. Defendant made use of said credit card and has a current balance due of \$1985.46 , as of November 13, 2006 .

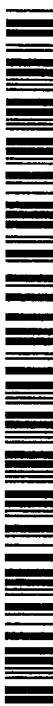

1. How To Avoid A Finance Charge.



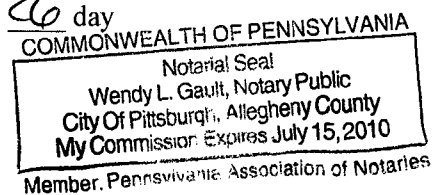


