

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



**COMPLAINT**

AND NOW, comes the Plaintiff, Laurie A. Cherry, by and through her attorney, Jeffrey M. Gordon, Esquire, who files the following Complaint:

1. Plaintiff, Laurie A. Cherry, is an adult individual who resides at 9 Nathan Court, DuBois, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, 15801.
2. Defendant, Edmund A. Grenier, Jr., is an adult individual who resides at RR4, Box 603, DuBois, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, 15801.
3. Defendant, Grenier Enterprises, is a Pennsylvania business entity whose business address is RR 3, Box 129, Reynoldsville, Jefferson County, Pennsylvania, 15851.
4. The facts and occurrences hereinafter related took place on or about June 8, 2005, at approximately 1:50 p.m. on Division Street, DuBois, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.
5. At that time and place, Plaintiff, Laurie A. Cherry, was operating her motor vehicle, a 2003 Volkswagen Passat Sedan, in a southwesterly direction along said roadway.
6. At that time and place, Defendant, Edmund A. Grenier, Jr., was operating a 2003 Honda CR-V Sedan owned by Defendant, Grenier Enterprises, which was traveling in a southerly

direction directly behind Plaintiff's vehicle.

7. At that time and place, Plaintiff, Laurie A. Cherry, had stopped her vehicle at the intersection of South Division Street and Beaver Drive in an attempt to negotiate a right hand turn onto Beaver Drive.

8. At that time and place, the front portion of Defendant's vehicle violently collided with the rear portion of Plaintiff's vehicle.

9. The foregoing accident and all of the injuries and damages set forth hereinafter sustained by Plaintiff are the direct and proximate result of the negligence, carelessness, wanton and reckless manner in which Defendant operated his motor vehicle as follows:

- a. failure to have his vehicle under such control so as to be able to stop within the assured clear distance;
- b. failure to keep alert and maintain a proper watch for the presence of other motor vehicles on the highway;
- c. failure to apply his brakes in sufficient time to avoid striking the Plaintiff's vehicle;
- d. failure to travel at a safe speed;
- e. failure to yield the right of way to Plaintiff's vehicle;
- f. failure to keep a proper watch for traffic on the highway;
- g. failure to drive his vehicle with due regard for the highway and traffic conditions which were existing and of which he was or should have been aware of;
- h. failure to keep proper and adequate control over his vehicle;

i. and otherwise driving his vehicle upon the highway in a manner endangering persons and property in a reckless manner with careless disregard to the rights and safety of others and in violation of the Motor Vehicle Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

10. Plaintiff, Laurie A. Cherry, sustained painful and severe injuries, which include, but are not limited to:

- a. shoulder pain;
- b. neck pain;
- c. headaches;
- d. neck pain with associated straightening of the cervical spine;
- e. trapezius muscle spasms;
- f. decrease of cervical range of motion;
- g. decrease cervical and scapular strength.

11. By reason of the aforesaid injuries sustained by Plaintiff, Laurie A. Cherry, she was forced to incur liability for medical treatment, medications, hospitalizations, and similar miscellaneous expenses in an effort to restore herself to health and claim is made therefore.

12. Because of the nature of her injuries, Plaintiff, Laurie A. Cherry, has been advised and therefore avers that she may be forced to incur similar expenses in the future, and claim is made therefore.

13. As a result of the aforementioned injuries, Plaintiff, Laurie A. Cherry, has undergone and in the future will undergo great physical and mental suffering, great inconvenience in carrying out her daily activities, loss of life's pleasures and enjoyment, and


claim is made therefore.

14. As a result of the aforesaid injuries, Plaintiff, Laurie A. Cherry, has been and in the future will be subject to great humiliation and embarrassment, and claim is made therefore.

15. As a result of the aforesaid injuries, Plaintiff, Laurie A. Cherry, has sustained uncompensated work loss, and claim is made therefore.






