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8. Neither party shall discuss any matters pertaining to the custody action or any legal matters with the minor child, nor shall they permit anyone else to do so.
9. Both parties shall communicate directly with each other with regard to the well-being and best interests of the child and shall not communicate through the child. Further, the parties shall fully communicate with each other to facilitate this agreement.
10. Neither party nor other family members shall malign or speak in a derogatory fashion about the other party in the presence of the child. Each party will exercise his or her best efforts to promote a healthy relationship between the child and the other parent and the other parent's family. The parties are directed to conduct themselves in a reasonable and appropriate manner at all times during their interactions with each other and their family members concerning the custody of the child and issues relating to the child's care and nurturance.
11. The party who has physical custody of the minor child will be responsible for scheduling and transporting the minor child to routine health appointments, including medical, dental, and ocular appointments, for yearly check-ups, vaccinations, and exams. The non-custodial parent will be notified of the scheduled appointment prior to the appointment and the results of said appointment.
12. Each parent shall keep the other informed of the progress of the child's education, any meetings or conversations with school teachers or school administration, any school
