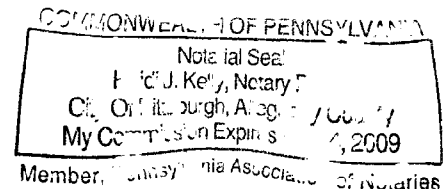

3. Plaintiff and Defendant entered into a Cardmember Agreement for a credit card bearing the account number 74981996936243 . A true and correct copy of the Cardmember Agreement is attached hereto, marked as Exhibit "1" and made a part hereof.

4. This account was subsequently assigned to Plaintiff for value.

5. The Cardholder Agreement contains a provision to settle by arbitration any claim, dispute or controversy arising from or relating in any way to the Cardholder Agreement.

6. Defendant made use of said credit card and has currently a balance due and owing to Plaintiff, as of December 06, 2006 , in the amount of \$8390.52 .


7. Defendant is in default of the terms of the Cardholder Agreement having not made monthly payments to Plaintiff thereby rendering the entire balance immediately due and payable.



NOTICE

This paper is a "Writ of Execution". It has been issued because there is a judgment against you. It may cause your property to be held or taken to pay the judgment. You may have legal rights to prevent your property from being taken. A lawyer can advise you more specifically of these rights. If you wish to exercise your rights, you must act promptly.

The law provides that certain property cannot be taken and sold by the Sheriff to satisfy your debts. SUCH PROPERTY IS SAID TO BE EXEMPT. No matter what you may owe, there is a DEBTOR'S EXEMPTION established by law. This means that no matter what happens, the Sheriff must give you from the sale at least \$300.00 in cash or property.
