

1. That the Plaintiff, LESLIE H. SMITH, is an adult individual, who resides at 385 LeContes Mills Road, Frenchville, Pennsylvania 16836.

2. That the Defendants are the sole surviving intestate heirs at law of Charlotte Bloom, who died intestate December 12, 1968:

(a) Velma Karadeema whose last known address was 5956 Route 76, Ripley, New York 14775-9727; however, she is believed to be deceased and her heirs are unknown;

(b) Doris (Loar) Snyder whose last known address was R.D. #2, Box 92 Mayport, PA 16240;

(c) Joy Diane Beaudin whose last known address was R.R. #1, Box 14 Mayport, PA 16240;

(d) Karon Ann Newmeister whose last known address was P.O. Box 6581, Big Bear Lake, CA 92315;

(e) Cindy Lee Welsh whose last known address was 437 7th Avenue Extension, Brockway, PA 15824;

(f) Tammy Welsh whose last known address was 920 King Road, Brookville, PA 15825;

(g) Robert LeRoy Bean whose last known address was 205 Shenks Ferry Road, Conastoga, PA 17516;

(h) Keith A. Konnerth, Sr., whose last known address was 1403 W. 18th Street, Lorain, Ohio 44052;

(i) Robert A. Konnerth, Jr., whose last known address was 9315 Dorothy Drive, Streetsboro, Ohio 44241;

(j) David S. Konnerth whose last known address was P.O. Box 667, St. Petersburg, FL 33713; and

(k) Kathy A. Hutter whose last known address was 23768 Sunset Crossing Road, Diamond Bar, CA 91765.

3. That the Plaintiff is currently the owner of a certain piece or parcel of land situate in the Borough of Troutville, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, hereinafter referred to as the "Premises" conveyed to him as joint tenant with right of survivorship with Andy Bloom by deed of Andy Bloom dated March 26, 1998, and recorded in Clearfield County Deeds and Records Book 1929, page 519 bounded and described as follows:

ALL that parcel or tract of land lying and being situate in the Borough of Troutville, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a one-inch iron pipe set by this survey, said iron pipe being along the northern right-of-way line for S.R. 410 (Main Street) (60-foot right-of-way), and also being along the eastern line of a 12-foot unnamed alley, and also being the southwest corner of the hereindescribed tract; THENCE North 43 degrees 42 minutes West along said alley a distance of ninety-nine and seventy-two one-hundredths (99.72) feet to an iron pipe set by this survey; THENCE North 48 degrees 9 minutes East along line of land of Muth, formerly Bloom, a distance of sixty-three and five one-hundredths (63.05) feet to an iron pipe set by this survey; THENCE North 43 degrees 42 minutes West along line of land of Muth, formerly Bloom, a distance of one hundred sixteen and twenty one-hundredths (116.20) feet to an iron pipe set by this survey; THENCE North 46 degrees 45 minutes East

along lands now or formerly of Sally J. Knarr, a distance of sixty-three and two one-hundredths (63.02) feet to an iron pipe set by this survey, said iron pipe being the northeast corner of the hereindescribed parcel; THENCE South 43 degrees 42 minutes East along lands now or formerly of Eugene J. and Marianne Fyda, a distance of two hundred seventeen and forty-four one-hundredths (217.44) feet to a drill hole set in concrete sidewalk, being the southeast corner of the hereindescribed parcel; THENCE South 48 degrees 8 minutes West along the northern right-of-way line of S.R. 410, a distance one hundred twenty-six and nine one-hundredths (126.09) feet to a one-inch pipe set by this survey, the point of beginning.

CONTAINING 19,936.6 square feet or 0.46 acre, in accordance with the survey prepared by Alexander & Associates, Inc., dated June 5, 1996, and recorded in the Clearfield County Recorder's Office in Map File No. 1219.

4. By deed dated February 3, 1947, and recorded in Clearfield County Deed Book 381, at Page 502, G. J. Cochran and Mary Cochran, husband and wife, conveyed a certain piece or parcel of land of which the "Premises" was a part to Andy Bloom and Charlotte Bloom, husband and wife.

5. On October 10, 1963, Charlotte Bloom initiated an action for divorce against Andrew Bloom a/k/a Andy Bloom in Clearfield County filed to No. 312 September 1963. The divorce action was finalized by Decree of Court entered April 22, 1964.

6. On February 21, 1966, Charlotte Bloom commenced a Complaint in Equity-Partition against Andy Bloom, a/k/a Andrew Bloom, her then ex-husband, requesting that a trustee be appointed to sell the parties' jointly-owned real estate

and distribute the proceeds equally. This action was in filed in Clearfield County at No. 1 February, 1966.

7. On March 18, 1966, the said Andy Bloom, a/k/a Andrew Bloom, through counsel filed an Answer but no further action appears of record with regard to the partition of the real estate of which the "Premises" was a part.

8. Plaintiff believes and therefore avers that the reason for no further action with regard to the partition action was that the said Charlotte Bloom and Andy Bloom a/k/a Andrew Bloom reached an amicable agreement whereby the said Andy Bloom a/k/a Andrew Bloom acquired any interest of the said Charlotte Bloom in the "Premises" but for some unknown reason, a deed evidencing this conveyance was never recorded.

9. The said Andy Bloom, a/k/a Andrew Bloom, died testate on June 14, 2002, naming the Plaintiff as his sole testate heir.

10. From at least 1966 until the transfer to Andy Bloom and the Plaintiff on March 26, 1998, the "Premises" had been assessed solely to Andy Bloom a/k/a Andrew Bloom.

11. Since 1966 until the transfer to Andy Bloom and the Plaintiff, the said Andy Bloom has treated the property as his own, residing on it and maintaining it, as well as paying all taxes.

12. The said Charlotte Bloom died intestate on December 12, 1968, being survived by three (3) daughters, Velma Karadeema, Edna Clarke and Verna Henricks.

13. The said Velma Karadeema's last known address is 5056 Route 76, Ripley, New York, 14775-9727.

14. The said Edna Clarke died November 8, 1984, being survived by her spouse, Champe Clarke, and the issue of her deceased daughter, Marie Konnerth, who had died April 2, 1967.

15. The said Champe Clarke died August 3, 1992, survived by Keith A. Konnerth, Sr., Robert A. Konnerth, Jr., David S. Konnerth and Kathy A. Hutter, the issue of his deceased daughter, Marie Konnerth, all of whom are named as Defendants herein.

16. The said Verna Henricks died August 28, 1986, survived by one (1) son, James Harold Henricks.

17. The said James Harold Henricks died April 4, 1996, survived by three (3) daughters, namely, Doris (Loar) Snyder, Karon Ann Newmeister and Joy Diane Beaudin, and the issue of Sandra Freeman, his deceased daughter, namely Cindy Lee Welsh, Tammy Welsh and Robert LeRoy Bean, all of whom are named as Defendants herein.

18. That from 1966, Plaintiff and his predecessor in title, Andrew Bloom, to the present, have exercised open, notorious and hostile possession and control over the "Premises" to the exclusion of all others.

19. That this Quiet Title Action is necessary to remove any cloud on Plaintiff's title to the "Premises" due to any irregularities in the chain of title because of unrecorded deeds and/or assignments and other documents, incomplete estate records of deceased persons showing a complete chain of title, and possible adverse interests of named Defendants, their heirs, successors and assigns.

20. That at no time have any of the herein named Defendants attempted to secure possession of the said "Premises", contest the title of Plaintiff or his predecessor in title or assist in the maintenance, repair or improvement of the "Premises" nor have they asserted any interest adverse to the Plaintiff by any legal action.


WHEREFORE, Plaintiff requests:

(a) That the Defendants be forever barred from asserting any right, title, lien or interest in the Plaintiff's land inconsistent with the ownership of the Plaintiff, unless the Defendants bring an action of ejectment against the Plaintiff for recovery of the land within thirty (30) days after the entry of judgment by the Court;

(b) That the Plaintiff be decreed as the sole owner and be entitled to exclusive possession of the premises described in the foregoing Complaint; and

(c) That the Court make such further orders as may be necessary to establish the legal and valid title of the Plaintiff and to grant him appropriate relief.
