3. Defendant applied for and received a credit card bearing the account number 4121742134998858 .


4. Defendant made use of said credit card and has a current balance due of \$3286.22 , as of January 12, 2007 .

5. Defendant is in default by failing to make monthly payments when due. As such, the entire balance is immediately due and payable to Plaintiff.

6. Plaintiff is entitled to the addition of interest at the rate of 25.900% per annum on the unpaid balance from January 12, 2007 . A copy of Plaintiff's STATEMENT is attached hereto, marked as Exhibit "1" and made a part hereof.

7. Although repeatedly requested to do so by Plaintiff, Defendant has willfully failed and/or refused to pay the balance due to Plaintiff.

Wherefore, the Plaintiff prays for judgment in its favor and against Defendant , HARRY J GHANER JR , INDIVIDUALLY , in the amount of \$3286.22 with continuing interest thereon at the rate of 25.900% per annum from January 12, 2007 plus costs.
