

**STIPULATION OF THE PARTIES FOR PAYMENT
AND FOR THE ENTRY OF JUDGMENT BY CONSENT**

TO THE PROTHONOTARY:

Kindly enter Judgment in favor of Plaintiff and against the Defendant, PHYLLIS A EMIGH, above-named, in the amount of \$5659.85 pursuant to the Stipulation of the Parties for Payment and for the Entry of Judgment by Consent, as follows:

1. Defendant admits indebtedness to Plaintiff in the amount of \$5159.85 with continuing interest thereon at a rate of 6.00% per annum from Date of Judgement, plus attorneys' fees in the amount of \$500.00 and costs.
2. To secure the repayment of said indebtedness, Defendant agrees that Judgment by Consent will be entered in favor of the Plaintiff and against the Defendant, PHYLLIS A EMIGH, in the amount of \$5159.85 plus continuing interest thereon at the rate of 6.00% per annum from Date of Judgement, plus attorneys' fees in the amount of \$500.00 and costs.
3. Plaintiff agrees not to Execute on its Judgment so long as Defendant causes to be delivered to Plaintiff the following payments in full by 12:00 NOON on the following dates:
 - (a) \$1000.00 downpayment due by MARCH 16, 2007;
 - (b) \$350.00 due by APRIL 16, 2007
 - (c) no less than \$350.00 per month due on the 16TH day of each consecutive month thereafter until the Judgment amount plus accrued interest and costs are paid in full.



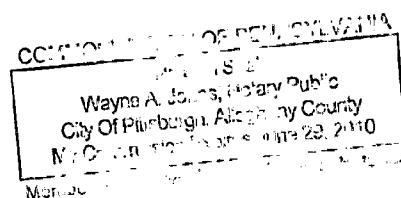


