
**ORDER FOR HEARING**

**PETITION FOR REVIEW OF AN ORDER OF DEPARTMENT  
OF TRANSPORTATION SUSPENDING OPERATING PRIVILEGE**

Petitioner, Wendy Ann Senior, by her counsel, Nathaniel J. Schmidt, respectfully petitions the Court pursuant to 75 Pa.C.S.A. §1550 for review of an Order of the Department of Transportation suspending Petitioner's operating privilege, and in support thereof represents as follows:

1. Petitioner, Wendy Ann Senior, is an adult individual residing at 37 Johnson Street, Byrnedale, PA 15827.

2. Petitioner currently possesses a valid driver's license issued to her in March 2003, which has not heretofore been suspended, cancelled, or revoked.


3. By letter mailed March 7, 2007, Petitioner was notified in writing from the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation that her driving privilege was to be suspended by means of an Official Notice of Suspension dated February 28, 2007, with a copy of such notice attached to this Petition as "Exhibit A." The reason for this suspension was stated as the following: a conviction under Judge Patrick N. Ford for Pennsylvania Magisterial District 46-3-01, finding that she violated §3345A of the Vehicle Code, passing a school bus on 12/12/2006. A copy of the conviction is attached as "Exhibit B."

4. The suspension is improper and unlawful for the following reasons: Petitioner has filed an appeal from her District Court conviction for violation of 75 Pa. C.S.A. §3345A. These charges may be dropped or dismissed in the course of future legal proceedings. Accordingly, the suspension of her operating privileges should be delayed until the appeals process has been completed.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests that the Court set this matter down forthwith for de novo hearing pursuant to 75 Pa.C.S.A. §1550 and that the order of the Department of Transportation be set aside.

This is an **Official Notice of the Suspension** of your Driving Privilege as authorized by Section 1535 of the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code. As a result of your 02/27/2007 conviction of violating Section 3345A of the Vehicle Code, **PASSING A SCHOOL BUS**, on 12/12/2006:

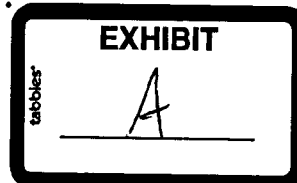
- Your driving privilege is **SUSPENDED** for a period of 60 days effective 04/11/2007 at 12:01 a.m.
- PennDOT is required by law to assign 5 points to your driving record.

Before PennDOT can restore your driving privilege, you must follow the instructions in this letter for **COMPLYING WITH THIS SUSPENSION**, **PAYING THE RESTORATION FEE** and **PROVIDING PROOF OF INSURANCE**. You should follow **ALL** instructions very carefully. Even if you have served all the time on the suspension/revocation, we cannot restore your driving privilege until all the requirements are satisfied.

**COMPLYING WITH THIS SUSPENSION**

You must return all current Pennsylvania driver's licenses, learner's permits, temporary driver's licenses (camera cards) in your possession on or before 04/11/2007. You may surrender these items before, 04/11/2007, for earlier credit; however, you may not drive after these items are surrendered.

**YOU MAY NOT RETAIN YOUR DRIVER'S LICENSE FOR IDENTIFICATION PURPOSES.** However, you may apply for and obtain a photo identification card at any Driver License Center for a cost of \$10.00. You must present two (2) forms of proper identification (e.g., birth certificate, valid U.S. passport, marriage certificate, etc.) in order to obtain your photo identification card.

**You will not receive credit toward serving any suspension until we receive your license(s). Complete the following steps to acknowledge this suspension.**

1. Return all current Pennsylvania driver's licenses, learner's permits and/or camera cards to PennDOT. If you do not have any of these items, send a sworn notarized letter stating you are aware of the suspension of your driving privilege. You must specify in your letter why you are unable to return your driver's license. Remember: You may not retain your driver's license for identification purposes. Please send these items to:

2. Upon receipt, review and acceptance of your Pennsylvania driver's license(s), learner's permit(s), and/or a sworn notarized letter, PennDOT will send you a receipt confirming the date that credit began. If you do not receive a receipt from us within 3 weeks, please contact our office. Otherwise, you will not be given credit toward serving this suspension. PennDOT phone numbers are listed at the end of this letter.
3. If you do not return all current driver license products, we must refer this matter to the Pennsylvania State Police for prosecution under SECTION 1571(a)(4) of the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code.

#### PAYING THE RESTORATION FEE

You must pay a restoration fee to PennDOT to be restored from a suspension/revocation of your driving privilege. To pay your restoration fee, complete the following steps:

1. Return the enclosed Application for Restoration. The amount due is listed on the application.
2. Write your driver's license number (listed on the first page) on the check or money order to ensure proper credit.
3. Follow the payment and mailing instructions on the back of the application.

**PROVIDING PROOF OF INSURANCE**

Within the last 30 days of your suspension/revocation, we will send you a letter asking that you provide proof of insurance at that time. This letter will list acceptable documents and what will be needed if you do not own a vehicle registered in Pennsylvania.

**IMPORTANT:** Please make sure that PennDOT is notified if you move from your current address. You may notify PennDOT of your address change by calling any of the phone numbers listed at the end of this letter.

**APPEAL**

You have the right to appeal this action to the Court of Common Pleas (Civil Division) within 30 days of the mail date, MARCH 07, 2007, of this letter. **If you file an appeal in the County Court, the Court will give you a time-stamped certified copy of the appeal.** In order for your appeal to be valid, you must send this time-stamped certified copy of the appeal by certified mail to:
