

We the undersigned persons appointed by the within order of Court, to view & lay out the road therein mentioned respectfully report,  
That having given notice of the time & place appointed for meeting, according to the Act of Assembly. And having all been present, at the view of the ground, proposed the said road, and having all been first severally sworn or affirmed, in pursuance of the said order, we have viewed and laid out, and do return the following road, viz. Beginning at the publick road near Cyrus Woods's Thence Thorough Land of the said Cyrus Woods, North One and a half Degrees East, Eighty Eight perches, Then North forty nine Degrees East, Ten & five tenths perches, North Thirty seven Degrees East, Twelve and five tenths perches, North Thirty two and a half Degrees East, Sixty perches, to line of Henry Bickel. Thence on the line between him & Cyrus Woods, North three Degrees East forty One and five tenths perches. Thence Thorough Land of Isaac Thompson North forty three East, Seventy Eight perches, North Thirty three West, Twenty four perches, North fourteen and one half Degrees West, Eight and five tenths perches, North Sixty Eight Degrees East, Twenty four perches, North Sixty three and one half degrees East forty four perches. Thence Thorough Land of Robert Leech's land, North Eighty two degrees, East, forty eight and six tenths perches, to the line of Leech & Isaac Thomas, Thence Thorough Land of Isaac Thomas, North Sixty four and a half Degrees East, Fifty Three and five tenth perches, to The Erie Turnpike, A Draft Survey of is herunto annexed. Which said road as aforesaid laid out, we are of opinion necessary for a publick road, and is of no damage to any person or persons, through whose land it passes.

## ROAD VIEWER'S REPORT.

### CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of September, A. D., 1870, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Bloom, in the said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway, leading from The Erie Turnpike at or near Isaac Thomas' to intersect the public road at or near Cyrus of Road in Bloom Township

*Report as to damages etc*

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do<sup>th</sup> order and appoint

Sam. L. McCloskey, Geo. A. Bloom and Jr. Ellinger

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or darft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.
