

NOW COMES, Mary A. Dixon, who, through her attorney, Joseph Colavecchi, Esquire, files her Preliminary Objections to the Plaintiff's Complaint and respectfully avers as follows:

1. Plaintiff filed a Complaint in the Court of Common Pleas of Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, on or about April 23, 2007, alleging that Defendant owes Plaintiff One Thousand Three Hundred Thirteen Dollars and Seventy-four Cents (\$1,313.74).
2. Plaintiff in their Complaint alleged they were attaching to the Complaint certain records designated as Exhibit "A". There are no records or documents attached as Exhibit "A".
3. There is no explanation of the basis for this Complaint.
4. The Complaint amounts to an allegation that there is an account owed by Mary A. Dixon in the amount of One Thousand Three Hundred Thirteen Dollars and Seventy-four Cents (\$1,313.74).

5. Plaintiff has failed to attach a copy of any agreement between Plaintiff and Defendant.

6. Plaintiff has failed to produce detailed statements showing how they arrived at the amount alleged to be due.


7. Plaintiff has failed to set forth the basis for their charges and legal authority for such charges.



5. Plaintiff has failed to attach a copy of any agreement between Plaintiff and Defendant.

6. Plaintiff has failed to produce detailed statements showing how they arrived at the amount alleged to be due.

7. Plaintiff has failed to set forth the basis for their charges and legal authority for such charges.

8. Plaintiff's Amended Complaint is insufficient on its face and should be dismissed because Plaintiff failed to produce any written agreement between Plaintiff and Defendant and further failed to produce a detailed monthly statement of the account setting out a description of the goods and/or services for which they alleged Defendant agreed to pay.

9. There is not sufficient information for Defendant to even enter into a proper defense of the claims.

10. The First Amended Complaint states that Plaintiff has requested documents from storage archives that are not currently available. However, Plaintiff is required to have the documents in his possession prior to filing the Complaint in order to properly file a Complaint in good faith. A reference to storage archives is insufficient and gives no notice upon which Defendant can enter into a defense of this case.

11. Atlantic Credit and Finance, Inc. vs. Giuliana, 829 A.2d 340, Super 2003, sets forth that if a claim is based upon a writing, the pleader must attach to the Complaint, a copy of the

writing, a cardholder agreement, a statement of account and evidence of assignment from credit card issuer.

WHEREFORE, Defendant respectfully requests that Plaintiff's Amended Complaint be stricken pursuant to Pa. R.C.P. 1028 on the grounds of legal insufficiency and pursuant to Pa. R.C.P. 1019(i).



1. A Complaint was filed on behalf of the Plaintiff on April 23, 2007. Preliminary Objections on Plaintiff's Complaint were filed on behalf of the Defendant on October 18, 2007;

2. In consideration of the Defendant's Preliminary Objections, the Court issued a Rule scheduling argument on December 7, 2007, at 10:00 a.m. On December 7, 2007, as reflected in the Court's Order of that date, Defense counsel appeared, while Plaintiff's counsel did not appear. Defense counsel at that time indicated to the Court, on the record, that he had received an Amended Complaint filed on behalf of the Plaintiff. Defense counsel had also filed Preliminary Objections to the Plaintiff's Amended Complaint on December 5, 2007;


3. The Court then scheduled argument on the

Preliminary Objections to the Amended Complaint for January  
4, 2008;

4. Upon the Court's review of the file, the Court discovered that Plaintiff has never filed an Amended Complaint, as was represented. However, Plaintiff did cause a copy of an Amended Complaint (which was never filed) to be mailed to Defense counsel;

5. In consideration of the circumstances, and that Plaintiff has not proceeded in a manner consistent with the Rules of Civil Procedure, it is the ORDER of this Court that the Defendant's Preliminary Objections be granted and the above-captioned case be and is hereby dismissed.
