annexed respectfully represent; that they advertised the time and place  
of meeting of the viewers by written & printed notices, put up at public  
points in the township of Burnside for more than five days previous to  
the meeting of the viewers. and having met at the time and place ap-  
pointed, and being first duly sworn or affirmed, proceeded to view the ground  
and proceeded to lay out the following road. Beginning at a stump  
on the line of the counties of Indiana & ~~Cleaveland~~ <sup>Cleaveland</sup> thence through  
land of James Brady, South Sixty one degrees East (thirty eight perches) in  
all forty four perches to small corner, South seventy eight degrees East, fourteen

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same; according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

John L. Cuttle, Jas. S. Hetzel & John Sunderlin.

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of  
Dukes Sessions for Claiborne County

Your petitioners, citizens of Burnside Claiborne Co.  
and vicinities respectfully represent, that they labor under  
great inconvenience, for want of a road, from a point at the  
county line adjoining Indiana County, near James Brady's, to  
the public road at or near James Goetz's in Burnside. If

Your petitioners would also represent that a public road  
has been laid out and made in Indiana County, ending in  
the woods, at the County line of Claiborne, (and only about one  
mile from the public over road leading to Burnside), and  
for want of said road being continued through to the river  
road; a large and thriving settlement, have no direct com-  
munication with Burnside, to the serious loss and disadvantage  
of both neighborhoods.

Your petitioners therefore respectfully ask your Honors  
to appoint surveyors to locate said road and as in duty bound  
they will ever pray &c.
