COMPLAINT

AND NOW, comes the Plaintiff, TERESA A. SHUGERTS, by and through her attorneys, NEISWENDER & KUBISTA, and files this Complaint against the Defendant, DENNIS D. CURRY, JR., on a cause of action upon which the following is a statement:

1. That Plaintiff, Teresa A. Shugerts, is an adult individual residing at 1102 Willow Drive, Clearfield, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania 16830.
2. That Defendant, Dennis D. Curry, Jr., is an adult individual residing at 301 Hill Street, Clearfield, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania 16830.
3. That on or about April of 2003, Plaintiff and Defendant entered into a partnership whereby they orally agreed to start a stock car racing team.
4. That per their agreement, Plaintiff and Defendant purchased a chassis, engine, trailer and various other tools and racing equipment over the next four years.
5. That in August of 2007, Defendant unilaterally decided to dissolve the partnership without prior notice to the Plaintiff.

COUNT I – BREACH OF CONTRACT

6. Plaintiff restates and incorporates Paragraphs 1 through 5 above as if stated at length herein.
7. That when Defendant decided to unilaterally dissolve the partnership in August of 2007, he and Plaintiff orally agreed to divide the assets of the partnership.
8. That per the oral agreement, Plaintiff was to receive the trailer, numerous tools and racing equipment.
9. That this agreement was entered into because Plaintiff had contributed almost all of the funds used to finance the operation of the race team.
10. That Defendant was to deliver the above items to Plaintiff's residence.
11. That as of the filing of this Complaint, Defendant has not delivered the agreed upon items to Plaintiff.
12. That Defendant has begun liquidating the partnership assets.
13. That Defendant's actions are a direct breach of the oral agreement between the parties.
14. That Plaintiff is entitled to monetary damages because she upheld the oral agreement and as a result has suffered financial hardship and loss.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff requests that your Honorable Court enter a judgment in favor of the Plaintiff and against the Defendant in an amount less than Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) plus interest and costs of the suit.

COUNT II – UNJUST ENRICHMENT

15. Plaintiff restates and incorporates Paragraphs 1 through 14 above as if stated at length herein.

16. That as a partner in the above-mentioned enterprise, Plaintiff is entitled to at least Fifty percent (50%) of the partnership assets.

17. That as stated above, Plaintiff had contributed almost all of the funds used to finance the operation of the race team.


18. That through his breach of the above-mentioned oral agreement, Defendant has retained all of the partnership assets for his personal use.

19. That as stated above, Defendant has begun liquidating the partnership assets.

20. That Defendant has been unjustly enriched as a result of his breach of the oral agreement between the parties.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff requests that your Honorable Court enter a judgment in favor of the Plaintiff and against the Defendant in an amount less than Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) plus interest and costs of the suit.


ORDER
