



COMES NOW, the Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Thomas W. Corbett, Jr., by and through Letty A. Kress, Deputy Attorney General, pursuant to and under authority of the provisions of the Judicial Code, Chapter 68, Controlled Substances Forfeitures Act, Sections 6801-6802, 42 Pa. (hereinafter referred to as "Act") and petitions this Honorable Court setting forth a right of possession in and requesting an Order of Forfeiture for \$2,219.00 U.S. currency a 2000 GMC Sonoma Truck, Vin #1GTCS1449Y8131855, and in support thereof avers as follows:

7. The defendant/properties are subject to forfeiture and condemnation and no legal right, title or interest exists in it by any owners or possessors of it pursuant to Section 6801(a) of the "Act," 42 Pa. C.S.A. Section 6801, (Relating to loss of property rights to the Commonwealth), based upon the following averment of material facts:

a. On March 27, 2007, Corporal Douglas Clark initiated a traffic stop on a 2000 GMC Truck for a speeding violation. The driver of the vehicle was

identified as Daryl Jason Taylor and his passenger was identified as Michael J. Amodeo.

b. Corporal Clark spoke to both occupants of the vehicle who gave conflicting stories about the travel destination.

c. Corporal Clark asked Taylor if he was transporting weapons and/or drugs and Taylor advised Corporal Clark that he had a gun in the truck.

d. Corporal Clark obtained consent to search Taylor's vehicle and Taylor signed the consent form.

e. Both occupants were patted down for officer safety. A glass pipe was discovered in Amodeo's pocket along with \$2,219.00 U.S. currency.

f. A K-9 conducted a search of the vehicle and alerted to a black bag in the bed of the truck. Upon searching the bag, nine (9) large bundles of marijuana were discovered. Taylor and Amodeo were taken into custody and mirandized.

g. An additional search of the vehicle uncovered ten (10) grams of crystal methamphetamine and a .45 caliber handgun.

h. Both Taylor and Amodeo admitted to transporting drugs for delivery in Pennsylvania.

8. The defendant/property, \$2,219.00 U.S. currency, was furnished or intended to be furnished by any person in exchange for a controlled substance, in violation of the Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act, or, is/are proceeds traceable to such an exchange, or were used or intended to be

used to facilitate any violation of said Act, or is/are otherwise subject to forfeiture under the "Act."


