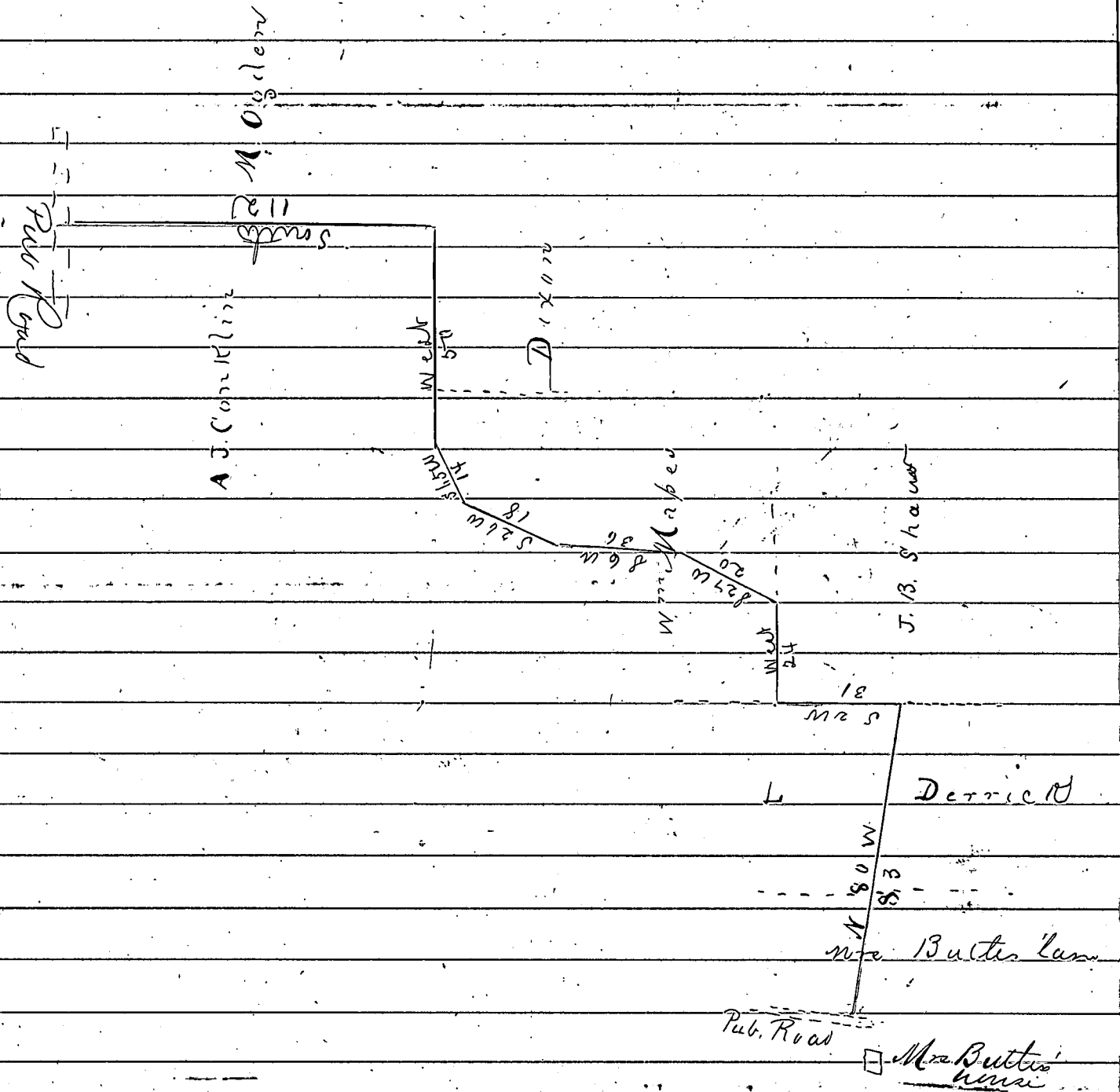

We the undersigned being appointed

That having given due notice of the
time & place of said view as required by the
Act of Assembly, and having been severally
affirmed on oath upon the ground proposed
for said road and having viewed the same
we do now return for public use the following
road to wit Beginning at the public road near

Butter Levi Denico's thence 80' West 83 paces
land of J. B. Shaw thence along land of Shaw & Denico
South 31 paces to Oliver Conklin's ~~land~~ thence between
Conklin & Shaw West 24 paces to pitch pine thence
S 27° W 20 paces, thence South 6' West 36 paces,
thence South 26' West 18 paces thence South 65
West 14 paces thence West along land of Conklin
50 paces to corner of land of J. Conklin & M. Ogden
thence by line between them South 112 paces to
public road near J. Conklin's house; which
said road we return as necessary for a public
road, a draft of a plot thereof is hereto an-
nexed. We further report no changes
to be made from said view

ROAD VIEWER'S REPORT.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 6 day of June, A. D., 1870, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Lawrence, in the said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway, leading from at or near the farm of Mrs. Margaret Butler to intersect a public Road leading from Clearfield to Ridgway at or near the Lands of Capt. Matt Ogden Report as to damages &c.

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

M. D. Bigler, Joseph Owens & Jas. B. Shaw who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.
