**APPEAL FROM ORDER SUSPENDING CERTIFICATE OF
APPOINTMENT AS OFFICIAL INSPECTION STATION**

1. The Appellant is Dennis J. Peck, having a mailing address of 873 Rich Highway, DuBois, PA. 15801.
2. Appellant is the owner and operator of "DuBois Care Care", located at 873 Rich Highway, DuBois, PA. 15801.
3. "DuBois Care Car" has been certified as an Official Inspection Station by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation and designated as Station No. X01.
4. The Appellee is the Department of Transportation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, having a mailing address of, PennDOT, Vehicle Inspection Division, P.O. Box 69003, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania 17106-9003.
5. By letter or notice dated March 31, 2008, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A, the Department of Transportation suspended the Certificate of Appointment as an Official Inspection Station issued to "DuBois Car Care",

for a period of two (2) months effective May 9, 2008, and ordered Appellant to surrender the Certificate of Appointment.

6. The action of PennDOT is suspending the Certificate of Appointment is based upon the allegation of PennDOT that the station conducted a faulty inspection of a 1995 Ford Truck.

7. Appellant hereby appeals the foregoing action of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation pursuant to the provisions of *75 Pa. C.S.A. § 4724(b)*.

8. The suspension of Appellant's Certificate of Appointment as an Official Inspection Station is alleged to be improper for the following reasons:

a. Appellant asserts that the inspection of the vehicle listed in the suspension notification was not faulty in any respect, but that the mechanical problems subsequently discovered to exist on the vehicle were caused by the use of the vehicle after the inspection was completed.

WHEREFORE, Appellant respectfully requests that this matter be set down for a hearing and that the action of the Department of Transportation suspending the Certificate of Appointment as an Official Inspection Station be set aside.

MOTION FOR SUPERSEDEAS


9. Appellant hereby incorporates the averments of paragraphs one (1) through eight (8) same as though set forth fully herein.

WHEREFORE the appellant respectfully requests that this Honorable Court will issue its Order of Supesedeas, staying the suspension of his Certificate as a Safety Inspector until the final disposition of this appeal.





ORDER OF SUSPENSION OF OFFICIAL INSPECTION STATION

You are hereby notified that your Certificate of Appointment as an Official Safety Inspection Station is suspended, pursuant to Section 4724 of the Vehicle Code. No vehicle safety inspections may be performed at your station during the suspension. Pursuant to Departmental regulations, your Certificate of Appointment will be suspended for two (2) months for faulty inspection of equipment or parts (1995 Ford VIN 1FTEF14N2SNB49743, sticker # AI7-4603874) by you.

The suspension(s) will run consecutively, for a total suspension of two (2) months. This suspension is to run consecutively with any other suspension(s) imposed by the Department for any violation considered separately. **THE SUSPENSION WILL BE EFFECTIVE** May 9, 2008. At this time, you are ordered to surrender to the Quality Assurance Officer, who is a representative of the Department of Transportation, your Certificate(s) of Appointment, and all safety inspection stickers. Two (2) weeks prior to the expiration of your suspension, you may contact your Quality Assurance Officer for reappointment. A complete and thorough investigation may be conducted to determine if you are qualified for reappointment.

You have the right to appeal this Departmental Order of Suspension to the Court of Common Pleas of the County in which the above referenced inspection station is located, **WITHIN THIRTY (30) DAYS OF THE MAIL DATE OF THIS ORDER**. If you do file an appeal, a signed and time-stamped copy of the appeal must be served upon the Department at the mailing address listed below. **FILING OF AN APPEAL DOES NOT AUTOMATICALLY STAY THE SUSPENSION.** In order for your privileges to be restored pending appeal, a signed Order of Supersedeas from the Court directing the Department to stay the suspension must be served upon the Department at the mailing address listed below.




