

AND NOW, comes the Petitioners, ***PATRICK J. REILLY and P. J. REILLY CO.***, by and through his attorney, ***CHRISTOPHER E. MOHNEY, ESQUIRE***, who files the within Petition against the above-captioned respondent pursuant to 75 Pa. C.S.A. §4724(b) for review of Order of Suspension of Official Inspection Station issued by the Respondent, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation suspending Petitioner's Certificate of Appointment as an Official Safety Inspection Station, and in support thereof avers the following:

1. Petitioners are PATRICK J. REILLY and P. J. REILLY CO., having mailing addresses at 227 Hamor Street, DuBois, Pennsylvania 15801.
2. Petitioners hold a Certificate of Appointment as an Official Safety Inspection Station, designated by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation as Station E47.

3. Respondent COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION has a mailing address at Department of Transportation, Chief Counsel's Office, Riverfront Office Center, 1101 S. Front Street, 3rd Floor, Harrisburg, PA 17104-2416.

4. By letter from Respondent mailed April 1, 2008, Petitioners were notified in writing by the Department of Transportation of the entry of an Order suspending its Certificate of Appointment as an Official Safety Inspection Station for the following reasons:

- a. for a period of two (2) months, effective May 7, 2008 as a result of an alleged faulty inspection of equipment or parts; and
- b. for a consecutive period of two (2) months for alleged improper record keeping.

A copy of the Order of Suspension of Official Inspection Station is attached hereto and marked Exhibit "A".

5. The suspension is improper and unlawful for the following reasons:

- a. Petitioners believe, and therefore aver, that Respondent cannot meet its burden of proof as to the allegations of faulty inspection of equipment or parts and/or improper record keeping for at least the reason that the alleged deficiencies with the inspection may have manifested themselves between the date of Petitioner's inspection and the date of the Respondent's representative's roadside inspection;
- b. the Respondent failed to consider the volume of inspections conducted by Petitioner and provide the owner or operator of the inspection center the opportunity to correct any inaccurate records;


c. Respondent is seeking to likewise suspend the mechanic whom performed the inspection in question's PATRICK J. REILLY's mechanic's certification as a safety inspector for the same alleged transactions and occurrences, the mechanic being PATRICK J. REILLY, JR. and whom is filing a contemporaneous appeal;

d. Respondent has failed to permit the station owner to consent to the acceptance of a point assessment in lieu of a suspension pursuant to 67 Pa.Code § 175.51.

d. such other reasons that the Court deems just.

WHEREFORE, Petitioners PATRICK J. REILLY and P. J. REILLY CO. respectfully requests that this honorable Court set this matter down forthwith for a hearing pursuant to 75 Pa. C.S.A. §4724(b), and that the Order of Suspension of Official Inspection Station of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation be set aside.

ORDER OF SUSPENSION OF OFFICIAL INSPECTION STATION

You are hereby notified that your Certificate of Appointment as an Official Safety Inspection Station is suspended, pursuant to Section 4724 of the Vehicle Code. No vehicle safety inspections may be performed at your station during the suspension. Pursuant to Departmental regulations, your Certificate of Appointment will be suspended for two (2) months for faulty inspection of equipment or parts (on a 1986 GMC, VIN-1GD6DIF1GV535208, sticker#S17-0227086) by you and two (2) months for improper record keeping. Further, the Department is including in this offense, the lesser included offense of careless record keeping.

The suspension(s) will run consecutively, for a total suspension of four (4) months. This suspension is to run consecutively with any other suspension(s) imposed by the Department for any violation considered separately. **THE SUSPENSION WILL BE EFFECTIVE May 7, 2008.** At this time, you are ordered to surrender to the Quality Assurance Officer, who is a representative of the Department of Transportation, your Certificate(s) of Appointment, and all safety inspection stickers. Two (2) weeks prior to the expiration of your suspension, you may contact your Quality Assurance Officer for reappointment. A complete and thorough investigation may be conducted to determine if you are qualified for reappointment.

You have the right to appeal this Departmental Order of Suspension to the Court of Common Pleas of the County in which the above referenced inspection station is located, **WITHIN THIRTY (30) DAYS OF THE MAIL DATE OF THIS ORDER.** If you do file an appeal, a signed and time-stamped copy of the appeal must be served upon the Department at the mailing address listed below. **FILING OF AN APPEAL DOES NOT AUTOMATICALLY STAY THE SUSPENSION.** In order for your privileges to be restored pending appeal, a signed Order of Supersedeas from the Court directing the Department to stay the suspension must be served upon the Department at the mailing address listed below.
