ROAD VIEWER'S REPORT.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 18 day of November, A. D., 1869, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Woodward, in the said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway, leading from the Wheatland Road at the point where the said Road diverges from the Clearfield Road in the village of Meadra to a point on the said Wheat Land Road at or near what is known as the Killenstone Shanties

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

Samuel Hager, John Harsh and S. C. Patchin

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the

shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

After being duly sworn according to law,

We the persons appointed to review and
supply the road within mentioned and parts
adjacent do report. That in pursuance of the said
order we did review the same and have laid
out for public use the following road, to wit, begin-
ning at a post in the ~~Wheatland~~ Road at the Eastern end
of the village of Madera near Alexandria Penn, thence
South 31 degrees East $1\frac{1}{2}$ perches to post, thence S. 57 E. $6\frac{1}{2}$ perches
to post, thence S. 39 E. 10 perches to post, thence S. 10 E. 7 perches
to post, thence S. 3 E. 46 perches to post in Wheatland
Road near Killingtown Manches, a draft of which is here-
unto attached.
