

PETITION FOR FORFEITURE AND CONDEMNATION

COMES NOW, the Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Thomas W. Corbett, Jr., by and through Robert B. Stewart III, Senior Deputy Attorney General, pursuant to and under authority of the provisions of the Judicial Code, Chapter 68, Controlled Substances Forfeitures Act, Sections 6801-6802, 42 Pa. C.S.A. 6801 et seq. (hereinafter referred to as "Act") and petitions this Honorable Court setting forth a right of possession in and requesting an Order of Forfeiture for \$14,000.00 U.S. Currency and one 2006 Chevrolet Impala, VIN: 2G1WC581169255419, and in support thereof avers as follows:

1. Your Affiant is Trooper Dennis Regal of the Pennsylvania State Police.
2. The defendant/properties are \$14,000.00 U.S. Currency and one 2006 Chevrolet Impala, VIN: 2G1WC581169255419, seized by the Commonwealth, pursuant to the "Act."
3. The defendant/properties were seized at or about 1:09 P.M. on or about Thursday, February 21, 2008.

4. The defendant/properties were seized at Interstate Route 80 eastbound at mile marker 123 in Bradford Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.

5. The owner of the defendant/properties, \$14,000.00 U.S. Currency and one 2006 Chevrolet Impala, VIN: 2G1WC581169255419, based upon all information currently available, is Francisco Lopez, 1300 West 9th Street, Cleveland, Cuyahoga County, Ohio 44413.

6. At the time of seizure, on the date and at the place of seizure, hereinbefore mentioned, the defendant/properties, \$14,000.00 U.S. Currency and one 2006 Chevrolet Impala, VIN: 2G1WC581169255419, were in the possession of Ralph James Jones, 16924 Grovewood Avenue, Cleveland, Cuyahoga County, Ohio 44110.

7. The defendant/properties are subject to forfeiture and condemnation and no legal right, title or interest exists in it by any owners or possessors of it pursuant to Section 6801(a) of the "Act," 42 Pa. C.S.A. Section 6801, (Relating to loss of property rights to the Commonwealth), based upon the averment of material facts in paragraphs 7A through 7 I, inclusive.

7a. On or about February 21, 2008 at or about the hour of 1:09 P.M., Trooper Brett Hanlon, Pennsylvania State Police, was monitoring eastbound traffic on Interstate Route 80 in Bradford Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, specifically at or near mile marker 123 on that highway, when the defendant/vehicle, operated by one Ralph James Jones, alias James R. Jones, came to Trooper Hanlon's attention.

7b. The specific Vehicle Code violations committed by the vehicle were having unlawfully tinted windows and an obstructed license plate [license plate cover].

7c. Trooper Hanlon effected a vehicle stop and spoke to the driver about why the vehicle had been stopped. In doing so, Trooper Hanlon noticed an overwhelming odor of air freshener and noticed several automotive air fresheners lying in and being about the said vehicle.

7d. Trooper Hanlon issued written warnings to the operator, for the equipment violations, then completed the vehicle stop and told the operator he was free to leave. He then asked the operator if he would mind answering a few questions about his trip and the operator agreed to do so and did answer the questions.

7e. Trooper Hanlon then inquired whether or not Jones had anything unlawful in the vehicle, to which Jones answered that he did not. Trooper Hanlon then asked Jones for permission to search the vehicle, which permission was granted by Jones.

7f. The vehicle was first searched via the use of a State Police narcotics dog, "Brenda," who indicated to the odor of controlled substances on the top of the center console and to the back of the center console. Trooper Hanlon then commenced a hand search of the vehicle and found indications which led him to believe that the vehicle contained a hidden compartment used to secrete contraband. Those indications were a piece of welded metal in the center console that appeared to him to be non-factory and being able to pick a screw driver straight up from along side of the center console. Trooper Hanlon then secured a search warrant and conducted a more thorough search of the vehicle.

7g. Following the issuance of the search warrant, Trooper Hanlon located wires leading to the center console of the vehicle. Those wires were stripped and then jumped. Then the back portion of the center console slid out, providing access to the

hidden compartment, which consisted of a hole cut into the center hump of the vehicle, with a non-factory installed floor underneath.

7h. Located inside the compartment were the defendant/property \$14,000.00 U.S. Currency, vacuum packed, a digital scale and a box of .22 calibre ammunition, plus several air fresheners, a brown ball cap, a grey knit hat, and a green towel. Also found inside the glove compartment were papers appearing to be, "owe sheets".

7i. Jones signed a Disclaimer of Ownership Form as to the Currency.

8. The defendant/property, \$14,000.00 U.S. Currency, was furnished or intended to be furnished by any person in exchange for a controlled substance, in violation of the Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act, or, is proceeds traceable to such an exchange, or was used or intended to be used to facilitate any violation of said Act, or is otherwise subject to forfeiture under the "Act."

9. The defendant/property, one 2006 Chevrolet Impala, VIN: 2G1WC581169255419, is a conveyance which was used, or intended for use, to transport, or in any manner to facilitate the transportation, sale, receipt, possession or concealment of drug paraphernalia, controlled substances, or other drugs which have been manufactured, distributed, dispensed or acquired in violation of the Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act.

WHEREFORE, the Commonwealth through the Attorney General prays this Honorable Court to issue an Order that the defendant/properties be condemned and adjudged forfeited to the Commonwealth and that all right, title or interest in the defendant/properties, except that vested in the Office of Attorney General,

Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, be declared null and void and that the property be used or disposed of in accordance with law.



1. On or about Thursday, February 21, 2008, the Commonwealth through the Pennsylvania State Police, seized the defendant/property as property subject to forfeiture under 42 Pa. C.S.A. Section 6801.
2. On or about July 11, 2008, the Commonwealth filed a Petition to Forfeit and Condemn the defendant/property.
