COMPLAINT

NOW COMES Plaintiff, Robert H. Peoples, by and through his attorneys, Hopkins,
Heltzel, LLP, and avers as follows:

1. Plaintiff Robert H. Peoples is an adult individual who resides at 2646 Behringer
Highway, Reynoldsville, Pennsylvania 15851.

2. The Defendants in this action are M.C. London and Thomas B. London. The
whereabouts of the Defendants are unknown and both Defendants are believed to have died prior
to 1950.

3. The legal description of the parcel to be quieted is:

ALL that certain piece or lot of land situate in the Township of Sandy,
County of Clearfield, State of Pennsylvania, bounded and described as
follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a cut in concrete center of State Highway know as Lakes to Sea Route being at the South East Corner of the land now or formerly Gerald Johnston, along the land now or formerly of Johnston, North 5 degrees 15 minutes East 348.3 feet to an iron pin or pipe;

THENCE East 85 feet to a post;

THENCE along other land of M. I. McCreight South 5 degrees and fifteen minutes West 350 feet more or less of center of State Road, and;

THENCE in center thereof, Westerly 85 feet more or less to cut in concrete, being the place of beginning.

4. The property described in Paragraph 3 was part of the larger lot known as the Prescott Tract that became vested in Clair D. Rugh and Mabel Rugh, husband and wife, by Deed dated July 29, 1935 and recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds in Clearfield County in Deed Book 310, at page 541 and recorded on March 26, 1938 in Deed Book 322 at Page 90.

5. By Deed dated August 14, 1947, Clair D. Rugh and Mabel Rugh, husband and wife, conveyed the property described in Paragraph 3 to M.C. London. The Deed was recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Clearfield County in Deed Book 387 at Page 20.

6. The next deed conveying the property was dated March 31, 1950. The grantors were Alfred A. London, also known as Alfred London, Russell London, James London, Paul London, Blair London, Evelyn London Pinchot, Grover London, Berenace London, also known as Bernice London Clark, Dorothy London Gotsch. The said grantors were identified as being all of the heirs at law of the late Thomas B. London. The aforesaid heirs conveyed the property described in Paragraph 3 to Harold C. Hannah and Lorraine Hannah, husband and wife. The Deed was recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Clearfield County as Instrument No. 2008-12030.

7. Harold C. Hannah died on November 23, 2006. Complete title to the property became vested in M. Lorraine Hannah by operation of law as surviving joint tenant. The said M. Lorraine Hannah did not remarry.

8. M. Lorraine Hannah died on December 13, 2006. Harold K. Hannah was appointed as the executor of the Estate of M. Lorraine Hannah by the Register of Wills of Clearfield County on January 18, 2007. Said appointment was filed in the Register in Recorders Office of Clearfield County January 18, 2007 as No. 1707-0031.

9. By Deed dated July 22, 2008, Harold K. Hannah, as executor of the Estate of M. Lorraine Hannah a/k/a Lorraine Hannah conveyed the property described in Paragraph 3 to Robert H. Peoples. The Deed was recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Clearfield County as Instrument No. 2008-12031.

10. Harold C. Hannah and Lorraine Hannah occupied, possessed and used the property as their own, openly, hostilely and notoriously and against claims of all other individuals and entities since March 31, 1950.

11. The said Harold C. Hannah and Lorraine Hannah and now Plaintiff, Robert H. Peoples, have adversely possessed the property against all other claims.


12. The purpose of this quiet title action is to remove any and all clouds encumbering the title to the property as a result of M.C. London's ownership of the property and Thomas B. London's ownership of the property.

partnerships, limited liability companies, corporate entities, or any other legal entity, or their legal representatives be forever barred from asserting any right, lien or interest inconsistent with the interest or claim of the Plaintiff in the property described in Paragraph 3.

Inasmuch as the last reference to M.C. London is in a 1947 Deed, it is believed M.C. London is dead.

As to Thomas B. London: A 1950 Deed identifies the Grantors as the heirs of Thomas B. London. He is therefore presumed to be dead. A search of the records of the Recorder of Deeds


and Register of Wills and tax records for Clearfield County revealed no record of a Thomas B. London.

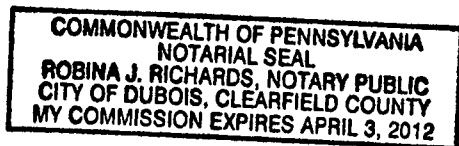
