





MOTION TO CONTINUE and CONSOLIDATE HEARINGS


NOW COMES, Sholynn Voigt, by and through pro-bono counsel, Stephen Jarrett, Esquire and respectfully requests that all outstanding motions filed by Christian Kirk be consolidated into one hearing of court and continued until January of 2009. In support thereof, respondent states as follows:

1. In zealous representation of her client, Kirk; Counsel Kubista has filed both a motion to change the surname of the minor child (listed Nov. 19, 2008) and an Emergency Petition for Custody, alleging that mother will not let father visit the child (listed date unknown).
2. Respondent/Mother's Pro-Bono Counsel has a trip planned on the date of the name change hearing to North Carolina to see his daughter who is enrolled in U.N.C., Wilmington.
3. Regarding the Emergency Petition; respondent represents that father is able to and does visit with the minor child on an at will basis, as does do the PGM and PGF.
4. Those visits will continue pursuant to previous written arrangements.

5. Petitioner Kirk may have not disclosed the frequency and content of phone calls made to respondent, which will have a bearing on any Emergency Motion.
6. Respondent is in the process of finding an entity to transfer the content of these calls from her wireless phone service to a form which will be provided to Counsel Kubista and played for the court at hearing. These calls reflect pickup and drop-off of the minor child.
7. Respondent's counsel is also seeking phone records that will validate (and authentic) times, dates and contents of calls transferring the minor child between the parties.
8. Respondent's cellular provider informs her that such records will be unavailable until the end of November at the soonest.

WHEREFORE , any previous written custody arrangements will (continued to) be obeyed to the letter, and name change does not constitute an emergency it is respectfully respected that with the proviso that visits continue uninterrupted, these matters be continued and consolidated; and relisted for the January term of court.

OPINION

The parties to this action come before the Court by the filing of a Petition by Christian H. Kirk, Jr. seeking to change the name of the minor child, Karsen Wyette Voigt, (d.o.b. 03-15-08). The Petitioner, Christian H. Kirk, Jr., is the Father of the minor child. The child was born out of wedlock to Petitioner and Respondent, Sholynn R. Voigt. The relationship of the parents ended prior to the birth of Karsen Wyette Voigt. Father was, however, at the hospital and did hold the child following birth but was prohibited from actually witnessing the child's birth. Following the child's birth, Father pursued confirming paternity through the Clearfield County Domestic Relations Section. Upon receiving confirmation that he was indeed the Father of said child, Father filed a Petition for Custody and the parties reached an Agreement and Consent Order but Mother failed to sign said Order. Father and the Paternal Grandmother have seen the child at Mother's discretion. An Emergency Petition was filed with the Court and the parties entered into an Agreement at the time of the hearing on said Petition.

This Court is authorized by 54 Pa. C.S.A. §702 to grant a name change, provided the Court determines that such a change is in the best interest of the minor child. These decisions are left to the Court's discretion. Petition of Christjohn, 428 A.2d 597, 286 Pa. Super. 112 (1991). Our Supreme Court of Pennsylvania has held that the Petitioner seeking the change of name has the burden of proof, and that the Court must consider the

natural bond between parent and child, the social stigma afforded the name within the community, and whether the child understands the significance, if of age. In re: Change of Name of Zachary Thomas Andrew Grimes to Zachary Thomas Andrew Grimes - Palia, 530 Pa. 388, 609 A.2d 158, 160, (1992). Furthermore, the Court must carefully examine all the relevant factual circumstances to determine whether the Petitioner has established that the proposed change is in the child's best interest. In re: Name Change of C.R.C. 819 A.2d 558 (Pa. Super 2003).

In this matter, there was absolutely no evidence or testimony presented before the Court which would permit the Court to determine that the child understands the significance of a name change. The child is only one year of age. All of the testimony presented through the witnesses established that Father had demonstrated that he and the child have bonded and that there is an established relationship between them. Mother herself testified that there was a bond between Father and Son. Testimony further established that the child was very comfortable with his Father. The Court is satisfied that despite being young, the child has reached a comfort level with his Father.

The Court is satisfied that no evidence was presented that the name Kirk carries with it any social stigma within the community and the last name "Kirk" is a respectable last name. The Court is well aware that Kirk is a very common name in the Clearfield County area.

The Court is satisfied that from review of the testimony that Christian H. Kirk, Jr. has played a role in the child's life by frequent contact with the minor child and by establishing a comfortable bond with the child. The Court is quite satisfied that a bond does exist between Father and his son. No credible evidence was presented that use of the

name Kirk would have any detrimental effect on the child. The Court is satisfied that Father has aggressively pursued his paternity rights and custody rights with regard to the minor child. The Court finds that Mother's position and conduct in this matter is unfounded and quite selfish on her part. Therefore, the Court is satisfied that Petitioner has shown that a change of name would be in his child's best interests and his Petition for Name Change must therefore be GRANTED.

Based upon the foregoing Opinion, the Court enters the following Order:

ORDER

AND NOW, this 30th day of June, 2009, following hearing on Petition for Change of Name, the taking of testimony and the timely receipt of Briefs and upon consideration of same, it is the ORDER of this Court that said Petition for Change of Name shall be and is hereby GRANTED and the child shall be known hereinafter by the name of Karsen Wyette Kirk.
