PETITION FOR LEAVE TO COMPROMISE MINOR'S ACTION

Pursuant to Pa.R.C.P. No. 2039, Lindsay McClure, parent and natural guardian of Jessica McClure, a minor, by her attorney, Richard H. Milgrub, Esquire, petitions this Court to enter an Order permitting settlement in compromise of this action and in support thereof avers the following:

1. Lindsay McClure is the parent and natural guardian of the minor-plaintiff, Jessica McClure, who was born on December 7, 2000 and who is presently 7 years of age.

2. Minor-plaintiff was injured on August 5, 2007 at the home of Susan Ayrault when she was bitten by a dog owned by the Defendant.

3. The injuries sustained by the minor-plaintiff were 3 cm. full thickness laceration of the right upper lip without nerve involvement, 1 cm. laceration puncture style of the right neck and abrasion of the right upper lip and chest. But for a minor scar, minor-plaintiff has recovered fully from all of the

injuries. Attached hereto and marked Exhibit "A" is a report from Dr. Jay L. Arlick, a maxillofacial surgeon, who examined the minor-plaintiff.

4. Minor-plaintiff's medical expenses have all been paid and there are no outstanding medical bills anticipated.

5. Counsel was retained by Your Petitioner to represent the minor-plaintiff on a contingency fee basis. Attached hereto and marked Exhibit "B" is a copy of said Contingent Fee Agreement. In prosecuting this action on behalf of the minor-plaintiff, counsel has incurred the following expenses:

a. Dr. Adam Miller (medical report)	\$ 180.00
b. Dr. Jay Arlick (medical treatment and report)	195.00
c. Processing of pictures	10.00
d. DuBois Regional Medical Center (medical records) (medical report)	25.00

6. Your Petitioner and her counsel seek approval of the settlement on behalf of the minor-plaintiff in the amount of Sixty-two thousand dollars (\$62,000.00) with Five thousand nine hundred ninety-five dollars (\$5,995.00) to be placed into an

insured savings account and the balance used to purchase a structured settlement. The specifics of the structured settlement agreement are attached hereto and marked Exhibit "C".

7. Your Petitioner approves the proposed settlement because she considers it fair and reasonable and it adequately compensates minor-plaintiff for the injuries sustained and expenses incurred.

8. Your Petitioner further approves the proposed distribution contained in the proposed Order attached to this Petition as Exhibit "D".

WHEREFORE, Your Petitioner respectfully requests that this Court enter an Order approving the settlement and compromise, allowing counsel fees and ordering distribution as set forth in the proposed Order attached to this Petition as Exhibit "D".


RE: Jessica McClure

Jessica was evaluated on February 8, 2008 5 months following dog bite injuries to her face. These were sustained on August 5, 2007 and repaired at DuBois Regional Medical Center. Presently she is having no physical complaints pertaining to the scars however she is having some emotional concerns due to peer comments at school.

An exam revealed a pleasant, healthy 7 year old female with an unremarkable medical history. Clinically she was noted to have three linear, thin, flat red scars. The first extending 10mm from the base of the right side of the nose; the second extended superiorly from the right side of the upper lip for approximately 5mm and the third was under her chin on the right side, 4mm in length. Although all 3 are healing well they are quite noticeable. As with any facial scarring some residual visible signs will always remain. As she is young the scars will normally improve and turn less red and more white hopefully becoming less noticeable. However as time progresses she will still probably need additional surgery to further change the appearance of the scars to make them less visible. Various options are available to treat scars but it is not necessary to elaborate upon these presently. I would still wait until the scars mature further before doing any surgical intervention. Regardless of whether or not surgeries are undertaken Jessica and her parents must realize that there will be some visible signs of the injuries that will remain forever.

POWER OF ATTORNEY

I, Jeffrey McClure, do hereby retain Richard H. I agree not to settle or adjust the above claim or any proceedings arising from said claim nor to discuss said claim with any other persons.

I agree to fully cooperate with my said attorneys in the prosecution of the claim that compromises the subject matter of this Agreement. This includes, but it not limited to, making myself available for legal proceedings and consultations with my said attorneys; keeping my said attorneys informed as to my current mailing address, phone number and the current status of my medical condition.

I warrant that the information which I have supplied and will supply during the course of these legal proceedings is true and accurate, and has not been and will not be obtained through fraud or illegal activities.

I agree to pay attorneys' fees from the total amount recovered from any source, except first-party benefits (i.e., work loss and medical benefits), on account of my bodily injury claim, including my claim for uninsured or underinsured motorist benefits, on the following basis:

Settlement of third-party tort total claim prior to filing of legal action.	<u>33 1/3</u> % of total sum recovered.
Settlement of third-party tort claim on or after filing of legal action.	<u>40%</u> % of total sum recovered.
Settlement of uninsured or underinsured motorist claims prior to selection of my arbitrator.	_____ % of total sum recovered.
Settlement of uninsured or underinsured motorists claims after selection of my arbitrator.	_____ % of total sum recovered.

Costs: Costs are to be paid from my (the client's) share of the total amount recovered and include, but are not limited to: photocopies, fax charges, postage, notaries, long-distance telephone charges, mileage for attorneys and staff, investigation charges, photographs, court costs, computer-based research charges, medical records costs, fee for police report, deposition costs, expert witness fees, stenographer costs, and video deposition fees.

In the event that no recovery is obtained on this claim, the attorneys will make no charges for their time or services. However, any costs or expenses that the attorneys may have advanced on behalf of the claim must be paid by me upon request by said attorneys.


As one possible settlement option, I authorize the said attorneys to explore the possibility of a structured settlement through the use of deferred periodic payments. I agree that if my claim is settled through such structure, the attorneys' fees may be paid directly to said attorney from the insurance company, either in one lump-sum payment at settlement, or at the sole option of said attorneys and/or insurance company, deferred into future payments. However, in any event, said attorneys' fees shall be calculated in the percentage as set forth above based upon the cost of the structured settlement or present value thereof in accordance with applicable law.

All medical bills for which I am legally responsible and incurred as a result of my injuries shall be chargeable to my share exclusively, unless otherwise paid by insurance.

This Contingent Fee Agreement applied to all proceedings up to and including verdict or decision at trial or arbitration, except proceedings which are or may be required to collect first-party benefits. If, in the discretion of the attorneys, post-trial proceedings, including appeals, are warranted, they will not be covered by this Contingent Fee Agreement and a new fee agreement will be required by said attorneys.

This Contingent Fee Agreement and Power of Attorney shall not apply to any right, claim or cause of action that we may have for collection of first-party benefits, (i.e., work loss benefits and medical bills).
