

COMPLAINT

AND NOW, comes the Plaintiff, **CEN-CLEAR CHILD SERVICES, INC.**, a Pennsylvania business corporation, by and through its attorney, **DAVID C. MASON, ESQUIRE** and makes the following Complaint against the Defendant, and in support thereof avers as follows:

1. Plaintiff **CEN-CLEAR CHILD SERVICES, INC.**, is a Pennsylvania business corporation with its principal office or place of business at 1633 Philipsburg-Bigler Highway, Philipsburg, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, 16866.

2. Defendant **BRADFORD J. SPENCER** is an individual with a mailing address of 111 Moss Creek Dr., Portage, Pennsylvania, 15946.

3. At all times material and relevant hereto, Plaintiff was a provider of mental health and social services to the public, and involved in the business of performing counseling,

therapy and other services to individuals with demonstrated needs.

4. Along with another individual named Malynda Allshouse, Defendant is the parent of a minor child, aged 7, who shall hereafter be referred to as "the minor".

5. On or about January 28, 2008, Plaintiff began treating "the minor".

6. The minor was designated as being in need of the services provided and performed by Plaintiff, **CEN-CLEAR CHILD SERVICES, INC.**

7. Malynda Allshouse arranged for this treatment and contracted with Plaintiff for the provision of services to "the minor", and represented to Plaintiff that Defendant would arrange for payment to Plaintiff through the insurance coverage available to "the minor".

8. The insurance coverage available for the treatment of "the minor" through Defendant's insurance carrier was denied due to the lack of a referral from "the minor's" primary care physician.

9. Despite repeated requests, Defendant neglected, failed and refused to obtain the said referral from the primary care physician, despite opportunities for doing so being open and available to him.

10. Defendant's failure to obtain the referral of "the minor" from the primary care physician was the direct and proximate cause of the loss of insurance reimbursement for the treatment Plaintiff rendered unto "the minor".

11. Defendant is the natural parent of "the minor" and, along with the mother of "the minor", responsible for payment of the ordinary and reasonable costs of care of said minor child.

12. Defendant is responsible for the mental health treatment received by "the


minor" under the doctrine of necessities.

13. Plaintiff's charges for the said care were ordinary and reasonable, and were the standard charges of Plaintiff for the type(s) of services provided.

14. Despite Plaintiff's repeated requests for payment, Defendant has failed and refused and continues to fail and refuse to make any payment whatsoever on the above referenced account.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff demands that judgment be entered in its favor and against the Defendant in the amount of \$680.00, plus interest at the legal rate, plus costs of suit.

11. Denied. Malynda Allshouse, the minor child's mother, has primary physical custody of the minor child and was the individual who took the child to Cen-Clear Child Services and




