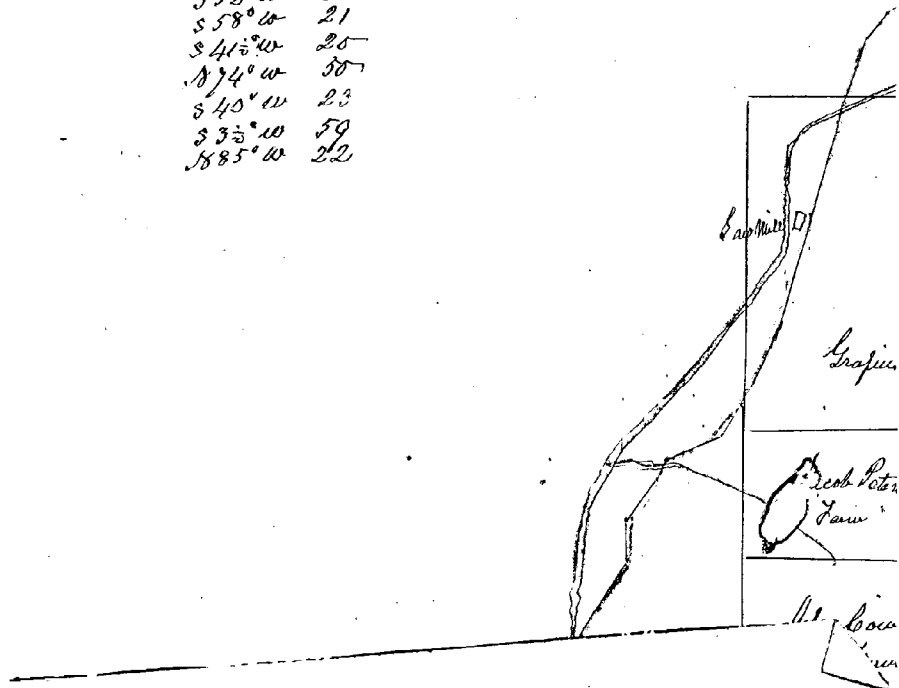

The undersigned viewers appointed by your Honors in and by virtue of  
the Order of Court hereto annexed, Respectfully Report, That they went upon the ground proposed  
for said road, after giving due and timely notice of the time and place of meeting of the  
viewers, for more than five days previous to the view being made, and being first duly sworn  
or affirmed according to Law, and out and now return for Public use, The following road,  
Beginning at the Mouth of a small run below Briggs & Hugges house thence S. 20° E. 10 per  
South six and one half degrees West, eighteen perches, South fifty two degrees West, three perches,  
South forty degrees West six perches, North fifty four degrees West six perches, South fifty nine  
West six perches, North seventy eight degrees West ninety six perches, South thirty three degrees West  
fifty perches, South two and one half degrees East twelve perches, South eighteen  $\frac{1}{4}$  degrees West, ten perches,  
South fourteen degrees West & run seven perches, South twenty & i degrees West twenty two perches, South  
forty & i degrees West, ten perches, South fifty four & i degrees West nineteen perches, South thirty degrees West  
perches, South ten degrees West fifty two perches, South twenty nine west, eighty two perches, two of  
Briggs fields, South fifty degrees West ten perches, South fifty eight degrees West twenty one perches,  
South forty one & i degrees West twenty perches, North seventy four degrees West fifty perches.

# Road Viewers' Report.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of June, A. D. 1872, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Bradford, in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway, leading from the forks of the Road at Henry Bumbargers to Gallows harbour which when layed out will connect with a road now being applied for and be the nearest route from Bigler Station to Frenchville

"Report as to damages &c"

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

John S. Little, Levi Hubler and Josiah B. Read

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.
