

DEFENDANT'S PRELIMINARY  
OBJECTIONS TO COMPLAINT

Clearfield Construction Co., defendant above named,  
by its attorney, Clarence R. Kramer, makes objection to the  
Complaint filed and served in the above case for the following  
reasons:


1. Paragraphs 3 and 4 are irrelevant and immaterial  
to the cause of action.
2. Paragraph 5 is irrelevant and immaterial to the  
cause of action and therefore surplusage.
3. Paragraph 6 is irrelevant and immaterial to the  
cause of action and therefore surplusage.
4. Paragraph 8 is insufficiently and inadequately  
averred; there should be designated which houses are involved.
5. Paragraph 9 is insufficiently averred; the complaint  
should aver which houses pertain to the averments therein.
6. Paragraph 11 is incomplete and inadequate in  
failing to aver dates, places, persons, details and the exact  
nature and terms of agreements alleged; and is further inadequate  
in averring in which houses oil tanks were involved; as to which  
houses electric water heaters were involved; as to which houses  
toilets were involved; and as to which houses lavatories were  
involved.

7. Paragraph 12 is inadequate and insufficient in failing to aver as to which houses the averments pertain; and as to dates; and as to places; and as to the personnel of the defendant alleged as to have made the request.

8. Paragraph 13 is insufficiently averred in failing to show by whom delivery of the invoices is alleged to have been made; to what person of defendant was delivery made; the dates of such delivery and the place.

WHEREFORE, defendant asks the Court to sustain these Preliminary Objections and hold the Complaint of the plaintiff to be insufficient and inadequate in its averments and content.

C O M P L A I N T

The plaintiff above named complains of the above named Defendant upon a cause of action. The nature and character of which is as follows:

(1). The plaintiff is a corporation incorporated under the law of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and its principal office and place of business is 312 East Market Street, Clearfield, Pennsylvania.

(2). That the Defendant is a corporation organized and existing under the law of the State of Ohio and is registered to do business in Pennsylvania. Its mailing address is Clearfield, Pennsylvania, P.O. Box 428.

(3). In March 14, 1958 the Torsell-Jordan, Inc. an Ohio Corporation made a deed to defendant corporation for certain land in Lawrence Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, which deed is recorded in Clearfield County in Deed Book 465 at page 419 and is incorporated hereunder by reference.

(4). By a deed dated December 28, 1960, the Defendant became the owner of an additional tract of land, also located in Lawrence Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, said tract adjoining the tract referred to in the third paragraph. The Deed for same is recorded in Clearfield County in Deed Book 487-page 48 and is incorporated hereunder by reference.

(5). That the Defendant Corporation and their predecessors in title, subdivided said parcel of ground into building lots, providing for streets and other necessary utilities and conveniences.

(6). That the Defendant Corporation or their predecessors in title caused certain maps or plats to be recorded in Clearfield County.

Among those recorded are maps recorded in the office of Recorder of Deeds in Miscellaneous Book 73 at page 415; Miscellaneous Book 105, page 351; Miscellaneous Book 110 at page 9. Said plans were prepared for and recorded by the Defendant Corporation, and are not available to the plaintiffs at this time. Therefore, no copies of this same are attached hereto.

(7). The Defendant Corporation undertook the construction of houses for sale.

(8). As to some of the houses, contracts were let for the plumbing, labor, and materials to be furnished.

(9). As to some of the houses, particularly those to be heated by hot air, the Defendant Corporation purchased from the Plaintiff Corporation for oil tanks, electric water heaters, and other plumbing materials for which they were billed and have paid, except in one instance, hereafter referred to.

(10). None of the plaintiff's claim, in this action, covers any of the properties, covered by specific contracts, or is it for toilet accessories, oil tanks, or electric water heaters, except in the case contract No. 52616 referred to hereafter.

(11). That in the houses as to which the plaintiff and defendant corporations had no contract, or agreement, the defendant frequently asked the plaintiff to install a sewer connection and to do all plumbing necessary for the installation of the various items it had purchased such as oil tanks, electric water heaters, toilets, lavatories, etc.

(12). That the Plaintiff Corporation did such work, after requested by the defendant on forty (40) to fifty (50) different occasions. The total amount of said work, after allowing the defendant a reduction of thirty (30) per cent over the usual price charged amounts to seven thousand and three hundred and sixty four dollars and seventy one cents. (\$7,364.71)

(13). The original invoices showing the house to which such labor and material was furnished has been delivered to the defendant, but copies of said invoices showing such totals are attached hereto, marked Plaintiff Exhibit A and made a part hereof.

(14). In addition thereto, the Plaintiff Corporation has done special work under a contract between them No. 52616, copy of which contract is in the possession of the defendant and the same is not attached hereto because of that fact, and that the statements of such contract are immaterial to this action. The balance remaining due on said contract is \$506.64. The items compiled in such work attached hereto marked Plaintiffs Exhibit B and made a part hereof and onto which an additional credit of \$48.86 and a payment received the 7th of March, 1961, leaving a balance on said job of \$506.64.


(15). At no time has the defendant denied the liability for such amounts, nor have they averred that the work and materials was not furnished, as herein averred or that the amounts claimed were unreasonable or excessive.

(16). On the bill of seven thousand three hundred and sixty four dollars and seventy one cents (\$7,364.71) the defendant allowed a special credit of twenty (20) dollars on twenty of the jobs, and an allowance of ten (10) dollars on twenty-two (22) other jobs, or a total credit of six hundred and twenty dollars for which they issued a credit memorandum to the plaintiff, and an additional credit memorandum for an error on figuring the Nelson job of \$22.49 making a total credit of \$642.49 leaving a balance due on the work performed of \$6,722.22. Said items making up such amount being shown on papers attached hereto marked Plaintiffs Exhibit A and made a part hereof. The credit memorandum for said item is likewise shown.



(17). That there remains due on the work not covered by contract the sum of \$6,722.22, with interest on the various items from the date the labor was performed, the items furnished, and on the special contract there remains due the sum of \$506.64, making a total of \$7,228.86 with interest thereon at the rate of 6% per annum for delay in payment for which sum the plaintiff asks that a Judgment be rendered in its favor and against the defendant at the trial of this cause.





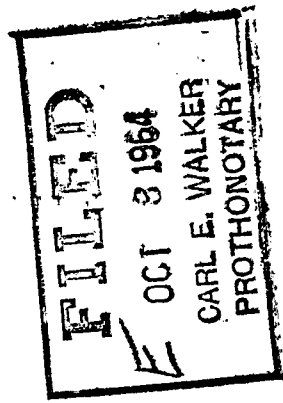

ANSWER OF DEFENDANT

The defendant denies the cause of action averred and answers as follows:

1. Admitted

2. Admitted

3. Denied as stated. There are 21 houses involved in this litigation and as to them the defendant orally employed the plaintiff to perform the labor and furnish the materials incident to installing the plumbing fixtures, the defendant having furnished the toilets, lavatories, all above ground fittings and having constructed the sewer into each house, and the plaintiff furnished oil tanks, electric water heaters and connected up the fixtures; the plumbing came largely prefabricated with even the soldering done to a large extent. And by the verbal arrangement, the services of the plaintiff were to be furnished to each house on the basis of, and after a pattern which, was first negotiated and the work completed as to two houses which were deemed model houses for the work to be performed and materials furnished by plaintiff; said houses are known as Number 25 (built for George W. Collamer) and No. 37 (Leonard Deromo, those numbers being the Lot Numbers and for convenience the houses being referred to by the same numbers); the billing was to take place and did take place promptly after completion of each house and was duly paid for. All subsequent

houses here involved were to be done in the same manner and involved substantially the same details as Houses No. 25 and 37, and at substantially the same cost. The variance in the original bills of plaintiff for the 21 houses being not more than \$10.00 for each house compared to the bill of each other house except No. 38, as to which the contract differed from the other houses. Further details are hereinafter averred.

4. It is admitted that when the houses were ready for the plumbing work under the package deal arrangement between the defendant and the plaintiff either William Jordan or Richard Law of the defendant telephoned Thorn's, Inc., to proceed with the work required upon the basis and at the prices established by the plumbing work done by plaintiff in the construction of Houses No. 25 and No. 37 which were model houses for that and other purposes.

5. As to Paragraph 5, it is denied that Richard Law was an Officer of the Clearfield Construction Company; he was Supervisor of Construction.

6. Denied. The charges now claimed for are excessive because plaintiff accepted the work on the basis of a price in accordance with that charged for houses 25 and 37, and in accordance with a sum for which there was prompt billing, which sum did not vary more than ten dollars from house to house and was virtually a lump-sum price for each house.

8. Denied that the work now claimed for was within

the scope of the contract between the parties. The invoices sued for under paragraph 8 of the Complaint are not the original invoices and are not invoices for items which should be paid for separate and apart from the payments theretofore made by the defendant to the plaintiff, inasmuch as the said plumbing work in each of the 21 houses was a lump-sum proposition and was based upon the cost to the defendant under the original billing for the work performed in model houses Nos. 25 and 37 and confirmed by separate prompt billing for each subsequent house; the invoices now sued for were not presented until approximately eighteen months after the first of the 21 houses was completed, long after the houses had been priced and sold on the understanding that plaintiff's sole cost was its original billing.

10. It is denied that a cost was incurred by defendant to the total averred in paragraph 10 of \$7,364.71, because the labor and materials performed as to each of the 21 houses was upon the basis of what it had cost the defendant to have plaintiff do the similar work on Model Houses Nos. 25 and 37, and in full reliance thereon, the defendant contracted with plaintiff for all of the 19 houses subsequent to the plumbing work done on Houses 25 and 37; and relied upon the first billing thereof, long since paid in full, and priced and sold its houses on the strength of such original billing as the item of total cost to this plaintiff.

11. Denied. It was on or about January 1st or 2nd 1960, that the plaintiff brought to the office of the defendant in Country Club Hills, the invoices now sued upon; finding the president of the company, William M. Jordan, not immediately available, he left the invoices on a corner of the desk of defendant without

comment, without explanation and without informing the secretary that they were being left. It was not until two or three days later that the defendant learned of the presence of such invoices in its offices.

12. The purported allowance of a discount of thirty per cent by the defendant is not applicable because the houses were served by the work of plaintiff upon the basis of a package deal or an approximate lump-sum figure which was billed after the work was done, and settled for in due course without any claim for any further obligation upon the part of defendant to plaintiff.

13. That the fact which the plaintiff avers was an error in billing pertains to the house of Eldon L. Nelson erected on Lot No. 60 in Country Club Hills was a discrepancy between a discount there purported to be allowed and that allowed for others of the 21 houses, namely, that the billing of January 1st or 3rd, 1960, had allowed in the case of Nelson's house only 10 per cent discount whereas to other houses 30 per cent was allowed, which correction occurred because it was first discovered by William M. Jordan, President of the defendant corporation. Nevertheless, it has no significance except as to its inconsistency, for the reason that it is a part of the attempted billing of January 1st or 3rd, 1960, as to which defendant disclaims all liability. The said Nelson original invoices were paid as submitted and the supplemental billing referred to in paragraph 13th is erroneous, improper and not a liability of defendant.

14. That the additional credits averred in paragraph



14th are not applicable for the reason that they were not a part of the original billing and were not within the original agreement, but apparently are an attempt to placate the defendant for the submitting of the supplemental bills of January, 1960, and the credits allowed in an effort to induce the defendant to pay those invoices.

15. The credits referred to are against charges which are beyond the contract and for which defendant is not liable.

16. The invoice of \$780.00 claimed for is admitted, but against said sum, the defendant has a counter-claim for work improperly and inadequately done, as follows: Interest paid to the Clearfield Trust Company, September 30, 1959, by defendant on a \$10,000 loan in the amount of \$115.82 of which plaintiff agreed to assume \$57.91; repairing the master bath shower in the property billed as W. Stringham, erected on Lot No. 41, in Long Meadow, occasioned by damage to the shower ~~had~~ by the installers' wrenches at the time of installation, \$24.90; repairing ceiling caused by water leak in the residence of J. A. Dame in Long Meadow on Lot No. 35, the damage being caused by imperfect workmanship, \$19.00, Total, \$101.81.

21. It is denied that the amount of \$6,722.22 is owing by defendant to plaintiff.

22. Denied. The defendant has at all times claimed that the sums were not a fair and just claim against it, and has continuously and resolutely insisted that no such sums whatsoever

are owing to the plaintiff by defendant. Such denial was made promptly upon discovery of the invoices left without notice by plaintiff at defendant's office, whereby William M. Jordan, of the defendant company telephoned Kenneth Gearhart, of the plaintiff company to the effect that the amount was not owing. The said account was further denied in the letter of February 3, 1960, written by defendant to plaintiff in which it was expressly called to the attention of plaintiff that the work was done upon a lump-sum or fixed price basis with the contracts performed on houses 25 and 37 as a pattern; the attention of plaintiff was then called to the fact that these several houses were to be completed on a fixed price basis, according to the pattern of the jobs on houses 25 and 37; and no invoices were ever rendered after the original invoices for installation and materials until approximately 18 months after the first house was completed and after the houses had been priced and sold relying upon the original billing as a complete statement of the amount involved and months after the payment of said invoices without calling defendants' attention to any alleged further charges.

23. Defendant denies the right of the plaintiff to judgment for any sum.

#### NEW MATTER

1. That the plumbing performed by plaintiff in the 21 houses was done on the basis of a price in accordance with that charged for the two model houses, Nos. 25 and 37, the plumbing work in which was intended to establish and did establish, the approximate cost of the plumbing work to be done in houses to be thereafter erected, especially the 21 houses in question.

2. That the plaintiff knew the extent and cost of the plumbing work done in model houses Nos. 25 and 37 was intended to fix the pattern for and establish the price of the plumbing work required in the remaining 19 houses.

3. That the plaintiff undertook the plumbing work in all of said houses on that basis.

4. That the plaintiff knew the houses were built for immediate sale and that the plumbing costs were an integral and important item in determining the sale price, and that therefore defendant had to know promptly the total of that expense.

5. That the plumbing work to be charged for was billed promptly to defendant, either at the time of completion of the work or very shortly thereafter, or in some cases before completion, and before the selling price of the respective properties was established or the properties sold.

6. That the houses were severally completed and separately billed for all construction work done by plaintiff as follows:

- (v) House on Lot No. 15, sold to James G. Holt, was completed July 28, 1958. The construction plumbing was billed as follows:

7. That all of the foregoing invoices averred in paragraph 6 hereof were duly and properly paid in due course by defendant to plaintiff and nothing remains owing under said invoices by the defendant to the plaintiff.

8. That all of said invoices set forth in paragraph 6 were rendered sufficiently promptly following completion of the work to enable defendant to take cognizance of those figures in establishing the sale price of the respective houses.

9. That the invoices now sued upon and enumerated and/or referred to in paragraphs 4 to 15, inclusive, of the amended complaint were withheld and not submitted to defendant until 18 months after the first of the 21 houses in question had been completed and billed for.

10. That the first notice the plaintiff gave to the defendant concerning the invoices now sued for, as referred to in paragraphs 4 to 15 of the amended complaint, was when plaintiff's representative, Kenneth Gearhart, left them on the desk of defendant company at its office in Country Club Hills on or about

January 1st, 2nd, or 3rd, of 1960.

11. That at the time of leaving said invoices on the desk of the defendant, neither the plaintiff nor any person for it called attention of the defendant or of any person or persons connected with the defendant to the leaving of the same.

12. That prior to leaving the said invoices as averred to in paragraphs 10 and 11, the plaintiff had made no mention of the same or the charges therein, nor of the fact that it had any claim against the defendant for construction plumbing work done in any of the said 21 houses; and thereby the first notice defendant had of any claim as now presented was 18 months after the completion of the first house and long after the completion and sale of each of said houses, the sale prices of which were fixed on the basis of all construction involved, including the completed plumbing.

13. That the plaintiff has been guilty of laches in suffering a claim which it knew to exist or could have known, and should have known existed, to remain dormant and without notice to the defendant until the defendant had fixed the sale prices and sold the houses where the plumbing is involved; thereby seriously prejudicing the defendant's business interests.
