



C O M P L A I N T

NOW, to wit, this 5th day of June, 1961,
comes the Plaintiff, JOSEPH X. ARICK, and by his attorney,
Edward T. Kelley, brings this action against the Defendants in
the above titled case to recover the sum of Five Hundred Ninety-
eight Dollars and Seventy-one Cents (\$598.71), with interest
from the 3rd day of August, 1955, which is justly due to the
Plaintiff upon a cause of action of which the following is a
statement:

1. The Plaintiff herein is Joseph X. Arick, who is
in the plumbing and heating business and resides at 317 Knarr
Street, DuBois, Pennsylvania.

2. The Defendants are Leo Pasierb and Catherine
Pasierb and Andrew Gulish, who reside at 317 West Second Avenue,
DuBois, Pennsylvania.

3. The Plaintiff avers that sometime before the 22nd
day of December, 1948, the Defendants verbally contacted him
and asked for a price on heating and plumbing for the above-
mentioned property.

4. That he figured a price for the heating and plumb-
ing, being just what they requested, which they verbally agreed.
On the original bill, for the heating, the amount was \$1,074.00;
and for the plumbing the amount was \$847.00, making a total of
\$1,921.00.

5. That before the completion of the said work, the
Defendants requested certain extras as set out in the bill,

marked Exhibit " A " attached hereto totally \$342.71.

6. That payment by the Defendants in the amount of \$1000.00 on November 22, 1948, and payment by them on August 3, 1955, in the amount of \$600.00 paid by them, and also a credit was given for \$65.00 for a radiator which was not installed, leaving a balance of \$598.71 for which this suit is brought, together with interest from the 3rd day of August, 1955.
