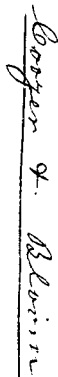

And Change the line, Between Bell and Chest Townships, respectfully
Report: That having given notice of the time, and place of meeting, according to the
Act of Assembly, and having all been present, at the time of the view of the
ground proposed for the said change, and having all been first
severally sworn or affirmed in pursuance of the said Order,
we have viewed the ground, proposed to be struck from Bell, into Chest Tp
believing that such is essentially necessary, we have made the
following change. Vize, Beginning at a Post Corner of Giles Tucker's land
^{from old 24th line} Thence by land of Cooper & Bloom, North forty two degrees west. One hun-
-dred and fifty two perches to a Post. Thence still by Cooper & Bloom
North Eighty seven and a half degrees west. Thirty five and five
tenths perches to a Post. Thence by land of J. B. Snyder South. Three
degrees west. Two Hundred and four perches to a Pin, Thence
by land still of J. B. Snyder North Eighty Seven degrees west
One hundred and seventy two and five tenths perches to a Pin
Stump Corner of J. B. Snyder & L. J. Hurd. Thence by land belonging
to John Lee, South Ten degrees East One hundred and thirty four
perches to a Post Old corner of ~~Barnes~~ Bell & Chest Tps.
Thence To the Beginning Containing One Hundred & Eighty acres
Fifty Eight and five tenths perches net. A Draft of which is
herewith Annexed, we Therefore Recommend That the said change
be confirmed.

ROAD VIEWER'S REPORT.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 26 day of September, A. D., 1870, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Bell and Chest, in the said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway, leading from Change of Township Line to wit beginning at Chest Tp. Line on north side of Chest Creek thence down said Creek 80 perches to white stump corner of now L. J. Hurd & J. C. Snyder thence north along said line to corner of J. P. Bloom thence by line of J. P. Bloom and Koser to corner of G. Tucker and old line of Chest and Bell and thus annexing the aforesaid part of John Graff survey to Chest Township And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint S. J. McCloskey, John I. Straw & John M. Cummings who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.
