COMPLAINT

1. The plaintiff is a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Delaware with its principal place of business in Ripon, Wisconsin.

2. The defendant, J. C. Rearick, is an individual trading and doing business as J. C. Rearick Home Appliance with his place of business at 133 South Brady Street, DuBois, Pennsylvania.

3. During the month of October, 1960, at the written request of the defendant, plaintiff sold and delivered to the said defendant certain goods, wares and merchandise of the kind and in the amounts set forth in the statements and invoices here-to attached, marked Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof.

4. That the prices charged the defendant were fair and reasonable at the time of sale and were the same as those charged other customers of the Plaintiff for the same kind and amount of said goods, wares and merchandise.

5. That the amount due the plaintiff for said goods, wares and merchandise is \$840.36 less an advertising credit of \$50.00 or \$790.36.



6. That plaintiff has demanded payment from the defendant of the amount due, but defendant has refused and neglected and still refuses and neglects to pay the same or any part thereof.

WHEREFORE, plaintiff demands judgment against the defendant in the amount of \$790.36 with interest from November 27, 1960.




