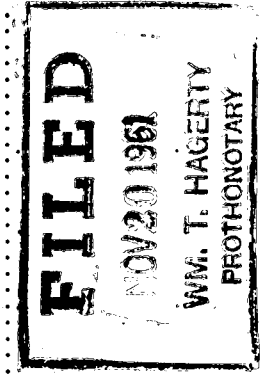

Plaintiff Sanitary Milk Company, Frank Hoffman, Jr. General Manager, appeared and being duly sworn presented his claim in the amount of \$29.73, against Defendant Russell C. Rowles, Defendant Russell C. Rowles appeared and admitted the claim to be true and correct, and stated he was unable to pay the amount of claim at this time, and would not say when he could or would pay it, depending when he would be able to get work or get the money to pay the claim.

Therefore judgment is publicly given in favor of the Plaintiff, Sanitary Milk Company, for the sum of \$29.73 and the costs of suit of \$10.20.

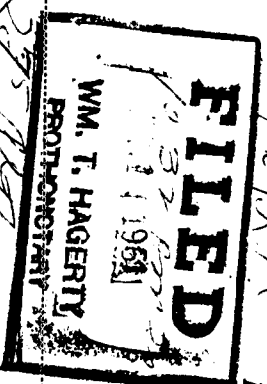
