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To the Honorable the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Clearfield County

We the undersigned viewers appointed by the above order of Court to view and lay out the road therein mentioned respectfully report —

That having given due and public notice of the time and place of said view by printed handbills as required by the Act of Assembly, we met at the time and place appointed and after being duly sworn or affirmed according to law, and all the viewers being present we went upon the ground proposed for said view and having viewed the same we report for public use the following road to wit — Beginning at the Public road between the house and barn of John Leis thence through lands of John Leis S. 48° W. 40 per. to post in woods near the southern line of said Leis. Thence through wood land of George Weisgarber S. 27° W. 9 per. to stump creek then on 5 per. more (14) to post, thence S. 17° W. 16.5 per to pine tree thence S. 8° E. 24 per. to post; thence S. 18° E. 18 per to brook then straight on through improved land of G. Weisgarber 24 per. more (total 43 per) to post at site of new barn; thence S. 37° W. 19 per. to stump; thence S. 7° W. 20 per to fence on line of Geo. Weisgarber; thence through wood land of Michail Schucker S. 30° E. 39 per. to post; thence S. 51° E. 17 per. to eastern line of Michail Schucker then straight on 17 per. more (total 34 per) through wood land of Henry Schucker to a little pine on the south side of the Spring gutter; thence along improved lands and on the bank of the Spring gutter S. 79° E. 14 per. to post; then S. 70° E. 33 per. to private road on the bank of the Spring gutter and on the eastern line of

ROAD VIEWER'S REPORT.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 21st day of March, A. D. 1871, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Brady, in the said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway, leading from

The Luthersburg and
Punksutawney Turnpike at or near the farm
of Henry Schuger to intersect public road at
or near the farm of John Leis
"Report as to damages &c"

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

H. Reams, Geo. Knarr & Amos Bonsal
who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.
