the Quarter Session of the Peace for the County of
Hampden

We the undersigned Viewers appointed by
the foregoing order of Court to view and lay out the
road therein mentioned, respectfully report:

That having given due and public notice by
printed handbills of the time & place of said view
as required by the Act of Assembly, we met at the time & place
appointed - to wit the 5th August 1841 - at Peter McGee's
all the Viewers being present - and all being respectively
affirmed according to law, we examined the ground
proposed for said view: and we do now return for
public use the following road: to wit: Beginning at the
township road near J. M. George's new house - thence
by line of land of E. J. Reed & P. McGee East to stone
corner of Martin Kline's land, thence by line of P. McGee
& Martin Kline farms North 20 perches to a corner
thence along the line of the farms of Genie Ayden,
Jach. Ayden W^m Ayden on the one side and the
farm of Martin Kline on the other side East 16 2 1/2 perches
to W^m Marshall's land thence through the same, the
same course East 33 perches to township road near the
Main Jay Church. and said road we consider necessary
for a public road. a draft or plot whereof is hereto annexed.

We further report that we assess the damages
due to Martin Kline by reason of said road at
forty dollars; and we report no other damages.

ROAD VIEWER'S REPORT.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the eighth day of June, A. D. 1871, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Lawrence, in the said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway, leading from

the public Road at or
near Peter McGeorges to the public Road at or
near the Mount Joy Church and School House.

Report as to damages &c

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

Wm D Bigler, Wm L Rishel and Rich. Shaw Jr

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.
